

EQUESTRIAN SPORTS NZ TIES JUMPING

FUTURITY SERIES 2025-2026



- For registered, eligible TB's in their first or second consecutive season in ESNZ competition.
- Must be registered with ESNZ for the first time from 1 June 2024 onwards.
- Seven qualifying rounds in North Island
- Seven qualifying rounds in South Island.
- Series Final held at Nationals in the South Island, and HOY in the North Island.
- Qualifying rounds up to 90cm.
- Top 5 previously unqualified combinations with 12 faults or less qualify for the Final - can go to both Finals.
- Final rounds up to 1m.
- Your TB **MUST**:
 - Be registered with the New Zealand Thoroughbred Studbook.
 - Be registered with ESNZ.
 - Have a Jumping discipline start.
- Bonus awards for the best performed TB's that have been bought directly from one of NZTR's acknowledged re-trainers.

To compete in the series, you must enter via Evo Events. ESNZ will then verify your eligibility.

Entries open on Evo Events on 10 September 2025.

Make sure your TB is registered with ESNZ before entering.
