Responsibility: It is the obligation of the rider, or person responsible, to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

Important Information

ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes: Entries will not be accepted without ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to 9th November 2025.

Preliminary: Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory Child or Full Competitive membership.

Novice and Above: Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.

Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/Pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use flexi start at \$5 per test (payable with entries).

ESNZ Registration for Non Graded Classes: All Riders must be a Full or Introductory ESNZ member or pay an ESNZ Casual membership fee of \$16.30 per day. Horses and Ponies maybe registered, or not be registered. **Restricted to riders who have not ridden above Elementary. Riders outside the restriction may ride Hors Concours.**

Rules: Dressage Hawkes Bay Premier League competitions will be run under the current ESNZ GR s, VR s & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.

Official start time: The official event start time is 12.00 pm Friday 7th November 2025. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ Article 420-430 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.

Official finish time: The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event, whichever is the latter.

Protests & Complaints: Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. Qualifiers: Premier League Shows are qualifiers for the Horse of the Year and Bates National Dressage Championships.

Dressage NZ Leagues/Series: Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young Rider and U25 Performance Leagues, or Top 10 League. Riders must register online at EvoEvents prior to 1st December 2025 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young Rider and U25 Performance Leagues.

Super 5 Tests: Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.

FEI Tests: Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.



Event Conditions

- Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
- Presentation of Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 456.
 - All riders must attend advertised presentations. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies or prizes/trophies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - The organising committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods of equal value.
 - Prize money will be paid by electronic transfer within 2 weeks of the completion of the event.
 - Prize Giving: Will be mounted for Champions & Reserves and Super 5 League, Zlico Musical Freestyles, Gold, Silver & Bronze Divisions, Pony, Junior Rider, Young Rider and Masters – All other classes collect from the drawers outside the beehive.
 - If 5 or less riders in a class, prize money will be paid out to 1st & 2nd whilst adhering to article Art 481 of the Dressage NZ Rules.
- Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 7.30 pm each evening on EvoEvents and the notice board. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
- All outstanding amounts from any previous Dressage NZ Event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
- Scratchings:** Are to be made via EvoEvents and must be followed by an email stating rider name and horse's name/s to nhbchampshow@gmail.com
- Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made via internet banking after the show
- Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
- Riders with more than 2 horses:** Maximum of 6 tests per day per rider.
 - Horses/Ponies are restricted to 2 starts per day, with exception for the YDH. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
- Helmets:** ESNZ approved riding helmets yellow tagged, must be worn at all times when mounted.
- Non-Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee gives permission otherwise.
- Media:** Dressage Hawkes Bay, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Dressage Hawkes Bay.
- Music:** Please e-mail this with Rider and Horse Name plus the Musical Level and Class to - hbdressagemusic@gmail.com by the 25th October 2025 in either an MP3 or WAV file. Plus bring a backup USB stick with you to the event. All music e-mailed in will be tested prior to the show.
- Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
- Liability:**
 - Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.

- b. Neither The Hastings District Council, Dressage NZ nor Dressage Hawkes Bay nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
- c. The Hastings District Council, Dressage NZ or Dressage Hawkes Bay shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such, brought in/stored at the venue, during the event.



15. Health & Safety:

- a. Dressage NZ and Dressage Hawkes Bay are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
- b. Competitors must comply with the appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
- c. Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event.
- d. All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Hawkes Bay and The Hastings District Council Health & Safety Policies.
- e. Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
- f. Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
- g. Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
- h. Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.

16. ESNZ Concussion Policy:

- a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
- b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
- c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing and also before leaving the grounds.

17. ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy

Entry Conditions

1. Entries Close: **Midnight Monday 20th October 2025.**
2. **Rider Volunteer Levy:** To encourage rider participation in running our show – and to help out with those jobs we pay people to do - we have introduced a Rider Volunteer Levy of \$30 per rider for all riders. This fee will be paid when you enter via Evo but if you would like your levy refunded in exchange for helping (Writing, collecting test sheets, Poo picking) please email Kyla (nhbchampshow@gmail.com) or specify preferred job at time of entry via EvoEvents within 24hrs of receiving your draw with preferred job. You may nominate someone else to take your place as volunteer. If no email or preferred job via EvoEvents is received from you, it will be assumed that you are happy to donate your rider volunteer levy and will not be allocated a job. **Every rider who does Volunteer goes in the draw to win a human body treatment kindly donated by 'Helen the Physio' (valued at \$90).**

3. Local riders **MUST STATE ON ENTRY VOLUNTEER TO HELP SET UP/RUN/PACK AWAY**. The OC reserve the right to **exclude local riders who do NOT help with the running of the event**.
4. Entry will not be accepted until payment is made. Combinations will only be entered in the competition draw once full payment of entry and other fees has been received.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries.

- Stabling and camping fees will be 100% refunded on request.
- Online entry fee, Rider Event Levy, and late entry fees will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no entry fees refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided within seven days, class entry fees will be refunded.
- If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.

- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration.

If event cancelled due to Covid-19

Championship Eligibility Points Levels Preliminary – Grand Prix

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th.
3. Champions and Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Award winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the Super 5 class is the winner.

Awards Bronze, Silver & Gold Award – Preliminary to Elementary

1. Combinations are eligible for one section only.
2. Section level as at evening prior to start of the show.
3. Points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th.
4. The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Award winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the Super 5 class is the winner.
5. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st only.

Age Group Award Eligibility

1. **Combinations are eligible for one Age Group Award only.**
2. **Champion Junior Rider:** For riders on a horse from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12 until they reach the age of 16. Riders who turn 16 on or after 1st August may continue competing as a Junior until the 31st July in the following calendar year.
3. **Champion Young Rider:** For Riders on a Horse or Pony from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 years until they reach the age of 21. Riders who turn 21 on or after 1st August may compete as a Young Rider until the 31st July in the following calendar year.
4. **Champion Pony Rider:** For riders on a pony until they reach the age of 17 years. Riders who turn 17 on or after 1 August may compete until 31 July in the following calendar year.
5. **Champion Pony Rider 12 years and Under:** For riders on a Pony until they reach the age of 13 years. Riders who turn 13 on or after 1 August may compete until 31 July in the following calendar year.
6. **Champion Masters:** Open to riders on horse or pony. Riders must be aged 50 years or over as at 1st August 2025.
7. **The two Pony sections may be combined depending on entry numbers**
8. Champion rosette only will be awarded.

Special Awards

1. **Pony Breeders Society Award:** A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed pony registered with the Pony Breeders Society NZ. Pony must be fully registered with the Pony Breeders Society NZ (Inc) that is to have a permanent registration number and to be foaled in New Zealand. **Please ensure PBSNZ registration number is uploaded onto the pony's record on EvoEvents.** Kindly Sponsored by KS Show Horses.

Age Group Championship Points

For Pony Riders 12 & Under, Pony Riders 13-16 Years, Junior Riders, Young Riders & Masters. In the event of a tie, the horse contesting the highest level will be the winner.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
3. Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.
5. Lunging is not permitted on the Oval.
6. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate.
7. **Familiarisation Times will be advised in the Riders Notes.**

Sponsors & Volunteers

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (Sponsors contact details will be listed on the event programme) or in person during the show. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the event office or event manager. Without the generous support we receive from these individuals and businesses, the cost to competitors would be considerably increased.

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

NO DOGS – The Hastings District Council RULES

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn on both sides at all times when warming up, competing and when being ridden or lead in Arena Familiarisation.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include person responsible name and mobile phone number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$60 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
6. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
7. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
8. Please use the bins/skips provided for horse waste not rubbish.
9. No smoking/vaping in any buildings or stable areas.
10. Damage to Tomoana Showgrounds facilities to be reported to the Event Office.

Camping & Power Sites

1. Parking and camping areas may be defined. Some areas will be restricted to onsite camping/parking only.
2. For fire safety reasons please park a minimum of 3 meters apart.
3. Trucks and Campervans requesting power must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords.
4. Please be tidy and use the wheelie bins for all rubbish – no animal waste in the rubbish bins.
5. Waste and grey water tanks must only be emptied in designated wastewater dumps.
6. Fire extinguishers must be carried and accessible in all vehicles camping on site.
7. Please ensure you have torch lighting available for use in the dark as there will not be other lighting sources available.

Vehicles & Access

1. Access to venue will be via Elwood Road, Gate 7.
2. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph.
3. Motorbikes must not be used after 8.30 pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules.
4. Persons under 16yrs may not use motorbikes.
5. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times.
6. Bicycle helmets must be worn in accordance with NZ road rules.
7. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated



Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.

- b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals
- a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professional Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors

Para Equestrian (PE)

Refer to General Conditions for the event plus for Para Classes please note:

1. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ General Rules and 2. Regulations and ESNZ Dressage Rules where applicable.
2. All riders must be current full financial members of ESNZ at time of entry, and current until at least 9th November 2025
3. All horses must have ESNZ registration at time of entry and current until at least 9th November 2025
4. All PE riders must have a current FEI or ESNZ ID card, a copy of which must be carried at all times while riding.
5. ESNZ, Dressage NZ & ESNZ Para-Equestrian rules apply from time of arrival where applicable.
6. All tests are the current versions that are on the ESNZ or FEI Website.
7. All Riders are to always display the Official Orange Para Badge on each side of their saddle cloth while schooling, hacking or competing as well as the horse's ESNZ registration number on both sides of the bridle or saddle cloth.
8. A horse may not be shared by different riders between PE and able-bodied classes.
9. A horse may be shared by riders of different grades in PE classes as per Article 166.
10. While every effort will be made to accommodate riders wishing to compete in both PE and AB classes and to accommodate PE riders with more than one horse, the smooth running of the event is paramount, and should there be excessive entries or timetabling issues, then riders may be asked to nominate which horse/discipline they want to compete in. No more than two tests per day per horse/rider combination can be entered.
11. There will be one overall Champion. The rider who achieves the highest combined percentages in any grade, over all tests will be the Para-Equestrian Champion.
