SHOW HUNTER CONDITIONS

- Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter rules.
- Show Hunter rules can be found on the Jumping/ Show Hunter ESNZ website.
- Only horses/ponies/riders wearing and using legal allowed gear will be allowed into the ring to compete. This includes warm-ups, introductory and open classes.
- There will be no blackboard order. Catalogue order only.
- Children's Equitation –A rider may only compete in one equitation series class at any given show either Waikato & BOP Show Hunter Pony Rider 12 & Under Equitation Series, or Pony Rider Equitation Series. Waikato and BOP Rider 12 & under Equitation series, riders must be 12 for the WHOLE season and not turn 13 during the season.
- Emerging Horse Series - horses that are NOT competing in any OPEN classes at this show. Riders may ride in both Emerging and Open classes, but horses may only compete in either or. Emerging Horse Show Hunters series will accumulate points from their class over the Ashburton ESNZ Jumping & Show Hunter shows during the 2025/2026 season. Points will be awarded (Pts+5,4,3,2,1) and presentation of this series will be at the February Show. 'Emerging Horse' series winner receives a special sash awarded by Rose Thomson.
- The 45 years and over Open this class is part of the Ashburton/Canterbury combined series competition. Overall series winner will be awarded at Canterbury Championship show March 2026.
- Ring One (Show Jumping) takes precedence over all other rings. However, to keep the Show Hunter rings running efficiently, a ten (10) minute allowance will be upheld. Riders who think they may be held up in Ring One, need to discuss this with the Gate Steward.
- Newcomer Pony Series, run over 3 pony Show Hunter categories, open to ponies in new to show hunter (First year registered or not yet registered). This series will accumulate points from the Ashburton ESNZ Jumping & Show Hunter shows during the 2025/2026 season. Points will be awarded (Pts+5,4,3,2,1) and presentation of this series will be the February Show.
- Newcomer Rider Series, run over 3 pony Show Hunter categories. Open to riders in their first season of show hunter (First year registered or not yet registered/Casual membership). Points will be awarded (Pts+5,4,3,2,1) and presentation of this series will be the February Show.
- Category B Pony- Canterbury and Ashburton Series will be run with the Category B Pony National Series class at each show. Points will be accumulated from this class at both Ashburton and Canterbury show during the 2025/2026 season. Winner of this series will be presented at Canterbury Championship Show March 2026. Winner to receive a dress rug.



SHOW CONDITIONS

- All classes run under ESNZ/JNZ/SHNZ rules. Please see the ESNZ website for current Rules and Series/High Points conditions www.nzequestrian.org.nz
- Ponies: One Championship, Grand Prix or Mini Prix class per day.
- Class 15 - Ponies with 20 penalties or less proceed to second round
- Class 14 – Horse with 20 penalties or less proceed to second round
- For Series Classes this show will pay prize money to 6th place regardless of the number of penalties in the first round.
- Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or amend any class as it deems fit.
- No new competitors or equines will be allowed to enter once the show has started.
- Dress code – Formal riding attire in all show jumping and show hunter rings.
- Riders must wear tagged helmets and must always be done up whether competing or training at any time on the grounds. Article 151 will be enforced. As per ESNZ Rules.
- Article 243 New whip rule – The whip should never be used more than three times in total, in the competition arena or in the practise arena.
- The Ashburton Area Show Jumping & Show Hunter reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry
- By entering or attending the Ashburton Area ESNZ Jumping & Show Hunter Show you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day.
- Official Photographers assigned to the event by Ashburton Area Show Jumping & Show Hunter organising committee are the only media to be sold or advertised.
- Concussions: Any rider that falls or has a knock to the head, must be checked by St Johns before remounting. Any rider deemed to be concussed will not be allowed to ride for the rest of the show. The new ESNZ fall card protocols must be followed. Should you fall during our event you will be issued with this card which must be signed by the attending medical officer (St Johns) before continuing and you must carry this card with you for the entirety of the show.
- ALL local Riders must provide help throughout the weekend. Please contact Sally Childs (0276307503) to be allocated a job.
- DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES AND CLEANED UP AFTER.

STABLING & YARD CONDITIONS

- Stables/Covered Yards & Open Yards will be allocated by the following; Stallions, level of competition then distance travelled. Yards/Stables are not allocated until payment is received.
- Manure & Rubbish – It is the Riders responsibility to clean up all hay & manure from their yards/covered yards/stables as well as from around your trucks & floats. Manure skips can be found at the end of each stable block. ALL RUBBISH MUST BE TAKEN HOME
- Yards and Stables will be inspected after the show. If a stable/covered yard/yard is not sufficiently cleaned out, you will be fined \$25 & blacklisted for the next show. Your allocated stable/yard is your responsibility! We suggest taking a photo of the clean yard clearly showing yard number.
- NO PORTABLE YARDS – EXCEPT for portable yards sourced by the Ashburton ESNZ Area Group
- All equines while not being ridden, MUST have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rugs as per jumping rules 200.7.1.

SCRATCHINGS & CLASS CHANGES

- Scratchings prior to close of entries or riders that have been issued with an ESNZ Blue card – Full refund (excluding non-refundable admin fee)
- Scratchings after close of entries - 75% refunds given with proof of inability to compete (Doctor or Vet Certificate only accepted). Doctor or Vet Certificate must be received within 1 week after the show. Administration, First Aid Fee & Evo Events Booking Fee non-refundable. No Vet or Doctor Certificate no refund. No Exceptions.
- There will be no refunds given on late entries.
- Scratching from a class and entering another class – 75% refund on scratched class, normal entry fee on new class entered.
- Scratching from class and no other class entered - No refund
- Changes must be made 30 minutes before the start of the class, except for the first class of the day which must be made by 5pm the day prior.
- All class changes/scratching must be made through the following options, 1. Complete & sign a form in the office 2. via email or 3. via Evo Events on the my entries tab
- Late Entries start first in all draw order competitions. (See article 252.2.2)
- Refunds/Prize Money/accounts will be credited to specified Bank Account within 2 weeks.

- Any balances owing at the completion of the show must be paid within 5 days of the show. If any balances are outstanding this will be added to your account and will need to be paid before entering our next show
