Fence judges: Individual riders must provide the name of a cross-country judge. Pony Clubs must provide three cross-country judges (per team).

DOGS are allowed on the grounds during the event **BUT MUST BE ON LEAD.**

Cross-country will be run on Saturday afternoon in the following order: Class 1, 4, 2, 5, 3, 6.

Showjumping for non-champs classes will take place on Saturday. Non-champs prize giving will be unmounted on Saturday afternoon at the completion of classes.

Showjumping classes for the NZPCA classes will be held on Sunday morning, followed by a mounted prize giving.

Non-champs classes are open to all riders. Non-NZPCA members need to complete a [**Casual NZPCA member form**](#) with their entry form.

Entry Fees:

\$85 entry fee per horse entered (team members, draft riders, individuals).

Plus : Ground fee: \$15

Yard fees: \$10 per day

Camping fee: \$15 per vehicle per night

NZPCA classes:

Rider selection and Eligibility: Riders must ride at their appropriate level.

Only genuine NZPCA/CNC65, NZPCA/CNC 80 & NZPCA/CNC 95 combinations are eligible.

- 65cm class combinations must not have achieved a National Qualification Standard (NQS) at 80cm or above, within the past 12 months
- 80cm class combinations must not have achieved a National Qualification Standard (NQS) at 95cm or above, within the past 12 months
- 95cm class combinations. **If combinations have achieved a National Qualification Standard (NQS) at 1.05cm or above, within the past 12 months, they may still ride, so long as they are not displacing a genuine 95cm rider but will incur a 10 point penalty.**

There is no minimum eligibility criteria but we recommend combinations have posted at least one score at the relevant level within the past 12 months.

- Teams to comprise of four to six riders: there must be at least one rider at each level. Four scores count for the team result. Final team scores must include one score from each level, **but only one 65cm score can be counted.**
- NZPCA classes are open to Pony Club members under 25yrs.
- Riders / team members may ride more than one mount in a team, at the discretion of their own club DC, but **must not displace another eligible rider.**
- Clubs are welcome to send more than one team, provided each team complies with the above criteria.
- WW Area will endeavor to accommodate any eligible riders into composite teams. Riders have the opportunity to be placed in a team as a draft rider, and can also ride as an individual representative of their pony club if there is no team available.
- Riders who are eliminated during day one may be eligible to compete in the showjumping on Sunday, if approved by the technical delegate. Approval must be requested on Saturday. These riders will ride first in their section.

Wairarapa Wellington Area Pony Club recognises the **Fair Play Charter**. Please abide by the spirit of the Fair-Play Charter when selecting and entering your team.

Teams will compete for the **Bruce Forbes Teams Trophy** and the **McKinstry Dressage Trophy**. The **McKinstry Trophy** is awarded on the best combined team score after the dressage phase.
