Important Information

- ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without membership as follows to 21st December 2025
 - Preliminary: Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Novice and Above: Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5 per Test (payable with entries).
- ESNZ Registration for Non Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Child, Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the 21st Decemebtr 2025 or pay a Casual membership fee of \$16.30 per event. Horses and Ponies are not to have current registration.
- Gold Silver Bronze Classes:** Classes will be open to all levels
- Rules:** Dressage Taihape Premier League competitions will be run under the current ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
- Official start time:** The official event start time is 12.00 pm Friday 19th December 2025. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ rules 420 - 430 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
- Official finish time:** The official finish time will be sixty minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event whichever is the later.
- Protests & Complaints:** Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. - Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for Horse of the Year and Bates National Dressage Championships.
- Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** : Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young Rider & U25 Performance League, or Top 10 Leagues. Riders must register online at Evo Events prior to 1st December 2025 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young Rider & U25 Performance League.
- Tests:** All tests are from DNZ Test book version 2023 or FEI Website
- Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted
- FEI Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted

Event Conditions

- Amendments:** The organising committe reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
- Classes 11 -14:** These classes are open to horses and ponies who are not currently ESNZ registered and must be ridden by riders who are C3 or less. Horses or ponies may be graded up to Level 3 or be downgraded. Combinations who do not meet this criteria are welcome to enter but must compete "Hors Concours"
- Presentation of Special Awards Prizes:** See DNZ Rule article 456.
 - a. The organising committee has opted not to give prize money and the entry fees for all classes reflect this.
 - b. Prize Givings: There will be a prize giving both days and details will be provided in the Rider's Notes.
- Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 6.30 pm each evening on the results board. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
- All outstanding amounts from any previous Dressage NZ Event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
- Scratchings** Must be notified by text/email to the Event Manager/Secretary (before 9pm)
- Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made via internet banking after the show
- Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
- Riders with more than 2 horses:** Entries are limited to 4 horses, with a maximum of 6 tests per day per rider. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
- Hats:** ESNZ approved riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted.
- Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee gives permission otherwise.

12. **Media:** Dressage Taihape, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Dressage Taihape.
13. **Music:** All riders must upload their music to EvoEvents by e music for their freestyle by Wednesday 17th December 2025. A wav. file is the preferred format (best quality) however an mp3 file is also acceptable. Note: This upload is event specific so you will need to upload to this event even if you have uploaded to a previous event.

Procedure on EVOEVENTS

- a) Once you have entered the show go to My Entries.
 - b) Click the 'More' button beside the show.
 - c) Enter a description for the music.
 - d) Select the file type called "Music for MFS".
 - e) Select the class and horse
 - f) Select the file to upload from your own computer.
 - g) Press the 'Upload Your Document' button.
14. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
15. **Liability:**
- a. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b. Rangitikei District Council, Dressage NZ or Dressage Taihape nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c. Rangitikei District Council, Dressage NZ or Dressage Taihape will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.
16. **Health & Safety:**
- a. Dressage NZ and Dressage Taihape are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
 - b. Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
 - c. Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
 - d. All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Taihape and Rangitikei District Council Health & Safety Policy's

Conditions of withdrawal form the event before close of entries.

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are still liable for for online entry fees.
- All other fees paid will be refunded.

Conditions of withdrawal form the event after close of entries.

- Stabling and camping fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fee, admin fee and late entry fees will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee and entry fees refund.

Awards

Bronze, Silver & Gold Award – Preliminary Only

1. Combinations are eligible for one section only.
2. Section level as at evening prior to start of the show.
3. Points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th.
4. The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Award winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the final qualifier is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % in two qualifiers will be the winner.
5. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st to 4th only.

Special Championships/Awards Eligibility

1. **Champion Junior /Young Rider:** For Riders on a Horse from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12 until they reach the age of 21. Riders who turn 21 on or after 1st August may compete as a Young Rider until the 31st July in the following calendar year.
2. **Champion Pony Rider:** For riders on a pony until they reach the age of 17 years. Riders who turn 17 on or after 1 August may compete until 31 July in the following calendar year. **Please state on entry to be eligible**
3. **Masters Championship:** Open to riders on horse or pony. Riders must be aged 50 years or over as at 1st January 2025.
4. Champion and Reserve Rosettes will be presented.

Special Championship/Awards Points

For Pony Riders, Young Riders and Masters. In the event of a tie, the horse contesting the highest level will be the winner.

HORSE UYSE

Sponsors & Volunteers

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing or in person during the show. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the event office or event manager. Without the generous support we receive from these individuals and businesses, the cost to competitors would be considerably increased. Keep an eye open for the very busy elves around the show and thank them as well.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
3. Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.
5. Lunging is not permitted on the oval at all times
6. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate.
7. Any person leading a horse in an arena familiarisation, must be wearing a correctly fitting yellow tagged helmet. All horses being lead must be wearing a bridle with a permitted bit, and with two bridle numbers. A newmarket lead may replace the reins for this purpose.
8. **Familiarisation Times** will be available on Friday afternoon (times will be advised with draw) and on Saturday and Sunday 30 minutes before classes commence and after all classes have completed.

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn on both sides at all times when warming up, competing and when being ridden or led in the Area Familiarisation
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include person responsible's name and mobile phone number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
6. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
7. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
8. Please use the skips provided for horse waste not rubbish.
9. Truck entry either side of the sheep pavilion. Please keep the gates shut
10. No smoking in any buildings or stable areas.
11. Damage to Memorial Park facilities to be reported to the Secretary's Office.

Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept in the truck park at all times
2. No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding areas, warm up, competition areas or buildings
3. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
4. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.

Camping Sites

1. Parking and camping areas may be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on site camping/parking only.
2. Day competitors must park in designated day parking areas
3. Please be tidy and use bins provided for all rubbish – no animal waste in rubbish bins.
4. Waste and grey water tanks must only be emptied in designated wastewater dumps.

Vehicles & Access

1. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph.
2. Motorbikes must not be used after 8.30 pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules.
3. Persons under 16yrs may not use motorbikes.
4. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times.
5. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated
6. Bicycle helmets must be worn in accordance with NZ road rules.

Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment

- a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarians and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event on a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
- b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
- c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
- d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

2. Other Professionals including freelance grooms

- a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full time employment of a competitor.

Para Equestrian (PE)

Refer to General Conditions for the event plus for Para Classes please note:

1. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ General Rules and 2. Regulations and ESNZ Dressage Rules where applicable
1. **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without membership as follows to 21st December 2025.
 - Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5 per Test (payable with entries).
2. All PE riders must have a current FEI or ESNZ ID card, a copy of which must be carried at all times while riding.
3. ESNZ, Dressage NZ & ESNZ Para-Equestrian rules apply from time of arrival where applicable
4. All tests are the current versions that are on the ESNZ or FEI Website.
5. All Riders are to always display the Official Orange Para Badge on each side of their saddle cloth while schooling, hacking or competing as well as the horse's ESNZ registration number on both sides of the bridle or saddle cloth.
6. A horse may not be shared by different riders between PE and able-bodied classes.
7. A horse may be shared by riders of different grades in PE classes as per Para-Equestrian Rules Article 166.
8. While every effort will be made to accommodate riders wishing to compete in both PE and AB classes and to accommodate PE riders with more than one horse, the smooth running of the event is paramount, and should there be excessive entries or timetabling issues, then riders may be asked to nominate which horse/discipline they want to compete in. No more than two tests per day per horse/rider combination can be entered.

THE GRASS CIRCUIT

The Grass Circuit Championships will run across three shows.

- Southern Hawkes Bay Dressage Premier League (Dannevirke, 29/30 Nov 2025)
- Taihape Christmas Championships (Taihape, 20/21 Dec 2025)
- Dressage Taranaki Premier League (Hawera, 10/11 Jan 2026)

Championship will be awarded at three levels.

- Unregistered (open to CN-C3 riders only)
- Prelim/Novice
- Elementary to Open Medium

Dressage Tests All dressage tests are Dressage NZ 2023 tests.

- Unregistered - 1B
- Preliminary - 1B
- Novice – 2B
- Elementary - 3B
- Medium - 4B
- Open Medium - 5B

Eligibility

- Riders must participate at all three shows listed above to be eligible to be awarded the “Grass Circuit” championship for their level at the conclusion of the Dressage Taranaki Premier League event.
- In the event that one of the three events cancels the nominated class, the combination must have been entered in that class prior to the cancellation.
- Riders may ride at different levels within the championship grouping described above, but not outside those group. I.e. a rider can ride at elementary and medium across the three shows, but may not ride at novice and elementary.
- Unregistered - all riders must have an ESNZ day membership or introductory membership.
- Prelim/Novice and Elementary-Open Medium - All riders must be Junior or Full ESNZ members, or introductory membership for preliminary riders only.
- Prelim/Novice and Elementary-Open Medium - Horses/ponies must have a full ESNZ registration, and may use a dressage annual start or dressage flexi-start.
- Horses/ponies downgraded as schoolmasters are eligible.
