

## Masters League Series 2025-26 90cm – 1.00m

1. The Series will be named the Woodhill Sands Masters League Series
2. The series will conclude at the Woodhill Sands SJ GP show 28 February – 1 March 2026.
3. **Eligibility**
  - 3.1 Riders are eligible when 40 years of age or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2025.
  - 3.2 Riders cannot have placed at 1.10m or over in the current/previous season.
4. **Registration**
  - 4.1 Riders must hold full ESNZ registration.
  - 4.2 Horses may jump on a flexi start or have a SJ start and full ESNZ registration.
5. **Points awarded**
  - 5.1 Points are awarded 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> placegetters as follows  
1<sup>st</sup> = 10, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 8, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 6, 4<sup>th</sup> = 4, 5<sup>th</sup> = 2, 6<sup>th</sup> = 1
  - 5.2 Double Points will be awarded at the Woodhill Sands December & January GP SJ show and the February Woodhill Sands Auckland SJ Champs Show 2026.  
Points will be award 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> placegetters as follows:  
1<sup>st</sup> = 20, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 16, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 12, 4<sup>th</sup> = 8, 5<sup>th</sup> = 4, 6<sup>th</sup> = 2
  - 5.3 Points will not be awarded to any combinations who have 12 faults or more in the first round.
  - 5.4 Points are award for a combination of both horse and rider, if a rider has two horses in one class they must nominate which horse they will score points on and then must ride this horse first.
5. The series winners will be the combinations with the highest 6 placings on the leader board after the final round at the Auckland SJ Championships February 2026.
6. Heights will be August—December 2025 90cm—95cm then January—Feb 2026 95cm — 1m
