Important Information

- ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without membership as follows to 1st February 2026
 - Preliminary: Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Novice and Above: Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5 per Test (payable with entries).
- ESNZ Registration for Non-Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Child, Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the 1st February 2026 or pay a Casual membership fee of \$16.30 per event. All non-graded classes will be run on Saturday only. Horses must not have been registered since 31st January 2025
- Non-Graded Classes:** All non-graded horses/ponies must be plaited. If insufficient entries Horse & Pony classes may be combined at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- Bronze & Open (Silver & Gold combined) Classes:** Bronze & Open Championships: These will be run for Preliminary and Novice levels only. Eligibility at the evening prior to the event. Bronze riders may opt to compete up in the Open category. Graded competition scores only to count; Freestyle scores are included. Preliminary Bronze – Rider must not have competed on any horse at Elementary level or above at any time. As a combination have not achieved 10 or more scores of 64% or above at any level. Preliminary Open – All riders that don't meet the Preliminary Bronze criteria. Novice Bronze – Rider must not have competed on any horse at Medium level or above at any time. As a combination must not have achieved 10 or more scores of 64% or above at any level Novice or above. Novice Open - All riders that don't meet the Novice Bronze criteria.
- Rules:** Ashburton Dressage Premier League competitions will be run under the current ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
- Official start time:** The official event start time is 12.00 pm Friday 30th January 2026 This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ Articles 420-430 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
- Official finish time:** The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event whichever is later.
- Protests & Complaints:** Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within

60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. 9. **Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for Horse of the Year and Bates National Dressage Championships.
10. **Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young Rider & U25 Performance League, or Top 10 Leagues. Riders must register online at Evo Events prior to 1st December 2025 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young Rider & U25 Performance League.
11. **Tests:** All tests from DNZ Test book version 2023 or FEI Website, <https://inside.fei.org/fei/yourrole/organisers/dressage/tests>
12. **Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted
13. **FEI Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted



Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Presentation of Special Awards Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 456.
 - a. All riders must attend advertised presentations. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - b. The organising committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods of equal value.
 - c. Prize money will be paid by electronic transfer within 2 weeks of the completion of the event.
 - d. Prize Givings: Saturday pm for all classes at their completion in conjunction with a Sponsor's meet and greet drinks & nibbles, proudly sponsored by Noble 600. All Non-graded prizes will be presented Saturday pm, including champion & reserve. Sunday pm at completion of Sunday classes for Champion & Reserve only, other rosettes may be collected from the office 30 minutes after final results are signed off.
 - e. Prize money will only be paid out on scores of 60% and above.
3. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 6.30 pm each evening on the results board and evoevents.co.nz. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
4. All outstanding amounts from any previous Dressage NZ Event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
5. **Scratchings** Must be notified by email to the ashburtondressage@gmail.com (before 9pm)
6. **Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made via internet banking after the show
7. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
8. Horses are limited to competing in one grade only; except for ponies who may compete in a Super 5 class and Novice MFS if they choose for National series points.
9. Riders are limited to competing 3 horses.
10. Riders competing more than 1 horse will be limited to 2 tests per horse per day. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
11. Maximum of 2 tests per day for per horse/pony.
12. **Hats:** ESNZ approved tagged riding helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.

13. **Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee grants permission otherwise.
14. **Media:** Ashburton Dressage, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Ashburton Dressage.
15. **MUSICAL FREESTYLES: OUR PLAYER WILL ONLY PLAY MP3 FORMAT; NO MP3 = NO MUSICAL.**
Music must be emailed to dressagemusicals2021@gmail.com by Sunday 25th January. Please be organised and not make another job for our small committee to have to chase riders up.
16. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
17. **Liability:**
 - a) Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b) Ashburton A & P Showgrounds, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Ashburton Dressage nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c) Ashburton A & P Showgrounds, Dressage NZ or Ashburton Dressage will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.
18. **Health & Safety:**
 - a) Dressage NZ and Ashburton Dressage are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
 - b) Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
 - c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
 - d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Ashburton Dressage and Ashburton A & P Showgrounds Health & Safety Policy's

Entry Conditions

1. Entries Close Sunday 11th January 2026
2. Entries will be limited to 119 competitors; these will be on a first entered & first paid basis. A wait list will apply thereafter.
3. Entry will not be accepted until payment is made. Combinations will only be entered in the competition draw once full payment of entry and other fees has been received.

Entry & Event Fees

Horse Accommodation Fees:

Stables/Covered yards \$30 per horse for the show (Friday 30th noon to Sunday 1st 6pm) ***

Uncovered Yards \$15 per horse for the show (Friday 30th noon to Sunday 1st 6pm) ***

Ground Fee (per horse) \$15 per day per horse

Camping Fees \$20 for the show (Friday 30th noon to Sunday 1st 6pm)***

Admin Fee \$15 per rider

*** Anyone wanting to stay outside the show time (Friday noon to Sunday 6pm) MUST contact the Event Manager, this is a health & safety requirement. Stables/Covered yards will be \$25 per night per horse, open yard \$12 per night, camping \$10 per night for outside the show times. ***

Withdrawals and Refunds

Conditions of withdrawal from the event before close of entries.

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are still liable for online entry fees.
- All other fees paid will be refunded.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries.

- Stabling and camping fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fee and late entry fees will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee or entry fees refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided ground fee and entry fees will be refunded less 20% per horse
- If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- If doctors certificate provided fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded
- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration.

Championship Eligibility Points Levels Preliminary – Grand Prix

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th .
3. Champions and Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner.

In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the final qualifier is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % in two qualifiers will be the winner



Awards

Tony Archibald Memorial Trophy

Masters Award. Open to horses and ponies. Riders must be 50 years or over as at 30th January 2026. Must be entered on EvoEvents. Championship Points will be allocated as below; from the B and MFS tests, Level 1 will be the C test in lieu of MFS. In event of a tie, the horse contesting the highest level will be the winner.

Highest Percentage Award

Garland awarded to the highest percentage across the show for graded classes, musical freestyles not included.

Harmony Award

The Harmony Award is given to an adult and child competitor. It is to recognise the connection between horse and rider and reward a harmonious partnership, as well as recognising when riders demonstrate compassion, respect and comradery towards other competitors. Riders that demonstrate stand out qualities of horsemanship or sportsmanship will be nominated. The award is not based or influenced on competition results.

Pony Breeders Society Award

Rosette for highest placed pony registered with the Pony Breeders Society NZ. Pony must be fully registered with a permanent registration number and be foaled in NZ. PBSNZ number must be uploaded onto the pony's record on EvoEvents. Points allocated as per the Tony Archibald Award Masters Award. Must be entered on EvoEvents.

NZHS Hanoverian & Rheinland Performance Series 2025/2026

Dressage NZ and the NZHS are delighted to launch the Hanoverian & Rheinland Performance Series for the 2025/26 season — recognising the breeders, owners, and riders behind New Zealand's top sport horses. Scores from Super 5 classes (Levels 1–9) at each Premier League show will count toward the Series. Awards will be presented separately for the North and South Islands, celebrating both breeders and riders/owners. North Island presentations will take place at the Bates Saddles National Dressage Championships on Friday 6th January 2026, at the NZHS VIP Function. South Island presentations will take place at the South Island Dressage Championships on 7 February 2026. If your horse is a registered NZHS Hanoverian or Rheinland, you're automatically included — no entry required. Behind every great horse stands a dedicated breeder, rider, and owner working together to make success possible.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. There will be no arena familiarisation as riders can warm up prior to their test in the oval.
2. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times.
3. Lunging is not permitted in the oval – see programme for details
4. THE RUGBY PITCH, DEAD BALL LINE TO DEAD BALL LINE, IS COMPLETELY OUT OF BOUNDS. Anyone who does not follow this ruling will be eliminated immediately from the rest of the competition and asked to leave the grounds.

Sponsors & Volunteers

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (Sponsors contact details will be listed on the event programme) or in person during the show. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the event office or event manager. Without the generous support we receive from these individuals and businesses, the cost to competitors would be considerably increased.

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn on both sides at all times when warming up, competing and when being ridden or lead in Arena Familiarisation.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include person responsible's name and mobile phone number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
6. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
7. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
8. Please use the manure bunkers for horse waste and take your own rubbish home with you.
9. Entry off Brucefield Ave only. Please keep the gate shut at all times.
10. No smoking or vaping in any buildings or stable areas.
11. Damage to Ashburton A & P Showground facilities to be reported to the Show Office.

Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept in the truck park at all times
2. No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding areas, warm up, competition areas or buildings
3. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
4. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.
5. Competitors & their associated people not following the above criteria may be disqualified from the competition & asked to leave the grounds.

Camping

1. Parking and camping areas may be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on site camping/parking only.
2. Please be tidy and remove all rubbish – no rubbish in poo bins

Vehicles & Access

1. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph.
2. Motorbikes must not be used after 8.30 pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules.
3. Persons under 16yrs may not use motorbikes.
4. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times.
5. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated.
6. Bicycle helmets must be worn in accordance with NZ road rules.

Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.

- d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals including freelance grooms
 - a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full time employment of a competitor.
