Under ESNZ membership rules all riders competing must be members of ESNZ – see below:

Riders

All riders must be a financial member of ESNZ (www.nzequestrian.org.nz) or pay a \$16.30 per event casual day fee which we collect on your behalf and pay in its entirety to ESNZ.

Horses/Ponys

Non-Graded - equines do not need to be registered or have Discipline Starts for this Dressage series. However, if your horse has current registration and has Annual Dressage discipline starts, you must enter the graded classes only.

Graded – Level 1: Intro Flexi or Intro Annual required

Graded – Level 2 and above: Full Flexi or Full Annual required.

Closing date: 25th of January 2026

The show will go ahead rain or shine.

Refreshments will be available on the day.



If sunny/dry, the arena will be watered.

General Rules & Conditions – Please Read Carefully.

1. **Health & Safety** - Competitors and spectators attending this show do so at their own risk, and they must abide by the WCEG Health & Safety rules, please ensure you read these, they can be found on the EE website along with the Disclaimer, also on www.horses.net.nz.
2. **Programme & Class Rules** - All classes are run under ESNZ rules. All riders must be a member of ESNZ (you can pay a casual day fee of \$16.30 if not an existing ESNZ member). The Committee reserves the right to - alter and/or cancel the programme if necessary within ESNZ rules. Max of 2 tests per combination per day.
3. **Bridle & Saddle blanket numbers** – If your horse has EVER been registered with ESNZ (even if not current), both ESNZ bridle numbers must be used. If not, you are required to use our saddle blanket numbers – this also applies to warming up, these can be collected from the office – pay with entry - refund given once returned. ID tags must be worn at all times (yarding, warming up & competing).
4. **Commanding of Tests** - All Tests may be commanded, except for FEI tests.
5. **Objections** - All objections must be lodged with the event secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a \$50 fee.
6. **Yards/ID Tags** – Day & overnight yards must be booked online at time of entry. Yards are compulsory & will be allocated (day yard – \$10.00 per horse per day, overnight yard \$10.00 per horse). Please ensure you leave your yard tidy, any damage will be charged out, yards with manure in will be charged out at \$20.00 per yard. Please ensure that your horse is wearing ID Tags at all times while in the yards (horse name and owner contact phone number). **There is no tying to floats/trucks at any time.**
7. **Rosettes** - 1st-6th rosettes in each class - these will be available for collection from the office 30 minutes after final posted score. We will not be posting out rosettes.
8. **Scratchings and Refunds** - Must be notified via EvoEvents prior to the event. During the event, see Kara in the office or phone 027 499 5055. Refunds will be given at the discretion of Organising Committee as follows – 100% of refundable fees prior to 6 January 2025 (no vet or doctor's Certificate required), 80% of refundable fees from 6 January 2025 – midnight on the 8th of January 2024 (with provision of Vet or Doctor's Certificate), no refund whatsoever from the 9th of January 2025. Refunds will be processed between the completion of the event and the 1st of February 2025. No refunds will be investigated or paid after this date.
9. **Dogs** - Must be kept on the carpark side of the road only and on a lead at all times.
10. **Horses** - All horses on the grounds **must** be competing, no companion horses allowed (including minis).
11. **Test Sheets** - Envelopes available from the office for tests to be sent out (cost \$3.00)
12. **Medical**: If any rider is injured or has a fall as at the start of competition (official start time 7.30am) they **MUST** be checked by our medic before they are allowed to remount.
13. **Competing riders and horses/ponies**: Under no circumstances are any riders or spectators, other than the competing riders allowed to sit and/or ride any horse/pony competing. Only horses competing are allowed on the show grounds.
14. **Stallions**: Riders to advise organisers of stallion's entry, requirements & must comply with the ESNZ article 133 of the General Regulations and Article 147 of the Dressage Rules.
15. **Classes**: May be split into ages or Pony classes if entries permit. The OC will decide once entries are closed.
16. **Refuse entries**: WECT reserves the right to refuse any entry.
