Conditions of Entry

- **Entries** close Friday 23 January **or when classes are full**. Enter online at www.evovevents.co.nz. All other event enquiries to Event Secretary, show coordinator Moana McKeen BrookbyHT@papatoetoeponyclub.co.nz or urgent 0212263133
- **Bank account # 12-3233-0002502-00 (Ref: Surname & 2DE). Entry not confirmed until payment received.**
- **All entrants from the greater AKL area must provide a volunteer for a minimum of 3hrs. Some roles can be completed pre or post show.**
- The organising committee reserve the right to restrict entries if necessary, amend classes and prizes as required.
- **Late Entries or non paid entries** after the close date incur a \$30 late fee
- **Non-competition Horses** - Not permitted.
- **Refunds:** If scratched prior to midday on Monday 26 January entry fee, yarding/camping fee and non compulsory fees refundable. All other refunds at OC discretion.
- **Timetable:** Dressage and Showjumping - Saturday; Cross-Country - Sunday.
- Back number holders are required for all classes.
- **All CCN classes** run under ESNZ eventing rules.
- **XC open for walking** – no later than 24 hours prior to commencement of XC – after Official Course Walk. Time will be emailed and posted on Facebook page.
- **Riders must use** their XC back number when schooling. Armband or bridle number in dressage and show jumping (or XC back number). **All horses must always have an ID** (either a personal ID or their competition number) on them whether being ridden or in the yards as per Article 651. It is preferable that those competing in National Classes (CCN and NZPCA) wear their XC #'s in all phases.
- **Back protectors** are compulsory for cross country (including in the warm up) and **MUST** meet the standard - BETA EN13158 2009/2018 Level 3 or ASTM 1937 and be red tagged.
- **Helmets** must be yellow tagged for all phases. If required, please bring helmet to the office for inspection before start of competition or risk elimination.
- **Dogs** **MUST** be on a leash at all times and under control.
- Bike riders must wear a helmet. No bikes permitted once XC has commenced.
- **NO** unofficial vehicles outside the parking areas.
- PLEASE ADHERE TO ALL HEALTH AND SAFETY SIGNS AND PROCEDURES.

ESNZ Membership Requirements

CCN1* and above	Rider- Full ESNZ Rider membership Required Equine- Full Equine registration required plus Discipline starts
CCN105	Rider- Full ESNZ Rider membership Required Equine- Full Equine registration required plus Discipline starts
CCN95	Rider- Full, Introductory or causal membership. Equine- Full Equine registration required plus Discipline starts
CCN80	Rider- Full, Introductory or causal membership. Equine- Must have at least a ESNZ causal registration (points wont count towards any series or have results reocred) or Full registration
CCN65	Rider- Full, Introductory or causal membership. Equine- NOT required.

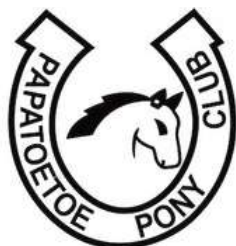

Papatoetoe Pony Club Disclaimer

1. **No liability:** Neither Papatoetoe Pony Club (**PPC**), Papatoetoe Adult Riding Club (**PARC**), any committee member of PPC or PARC, any organiser or sponsor of any event hosted by PPC or PARC, nor any service provider or volunteer at any event hosted by PPC or PARC (each a **PPC Party**) on the grounds at 2 Sutton Road, Brookby, Auckland, including the facilities made available at that address (the **PPC Grounds**), is liable:

- a) to any rider, owner, spectator or any person supporting, or otherwise attending the PPC Grounds with, any rider, owner or spectator (each a PPC Ground User) for any personal injury, accident, harm, incapacity or death, arising in connection with, or in any way related to, a PPC Ground User being present at or using the facilities on the PPC Grounds for any purpose, including any event, competition or open day (the PPC Ground Use); or
