

*** RIDERS NOTES ***

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

We have a busy weekend ahead with 265 combinations ranging from 65-3*. More volunteers are required! Please help where you can.

There are several road closures in our area including part of Brookby Road. Please check your route.

Office is located upstairs in the pavilion. Please use external stairs to visit us.

Don't be afraid to ask a question, if you don't understand something we would rather you ask.

Helmet and back protector tagging is available on Friday afternoon 4-6pm and Saturday morning from 7-8am.

Draw and timetable - will be emailed by Wednesday and will be on EvoEvents.

Updates will be through our Facebook page so please ensure you have liked and are following the Brookby Horse Trial page. Remember Timetables are subject to change.

Arrival time – we know you're eager to see us and to get settled in but gates will not open until after 10am on Friday.

All parking areas will be tight! Day parking for 4WD floats will be in paddock 10. Drive straight towards pavilion and turn right before you get to covered concrete yards. Day parking for trucks will be around arenas. For campers - no horses to be tied up to vehicles in truck park, please use your yards for tacking up. If you are parking on grass areas, we recommend you walk the area first. No vehicles permitted in paddocks by F yards. All drivers please park as close as possible.

Papatoetoe Pony Club is on tank water. If you like to give your horse a full spa treatment before an event, please do this at home! Turn off all taps properly and if you are using wash bays remove all muck and poo when you are finished.

Riding areas - no warmup riding permitted in the taped off areas or the arenas. You can school outside of taped areas around dressage arenas or next to sand arena (Ring 2 SJ warm up by black water tanks). Our bridle paths are also available for hacking.

Back Numbers - will be emailed, please print and don't forget your number holder. Back numbers must be worn when mounted.

Horse Numbers - Your horse requires a bridle number for every phase. This is to be worn on the left side. ID tags are required in yards; these must include your name and contact phone number.

Helmets must be worn on all bikes. Once XC starts on Sunday no bikes permitted on course.

Well-behaved dogs are permitted onsite but must always be on a leash. No dogs are allowed in our arenas. Once XC starts on Sunday no dogs permitted on course. Pick up after your dog please.

Dressage arena - located on the grass with Arena 1 closest to truck park. There are two gateways to get into this area; one located near Arena 1 and one by Arena 6.

Show jumping - will be in our arenas. Ring 1 is the ebb and flo arena closest to pavilion. Warm up is in this Ring. Ring 2 is the sand arena with warm up in separate ring behind the hedge (by black water tanks). All showjumping will be in whiteboard order. The timetable for showjumping is available on Evo and on the noticeboard at the pavilion. Rings will not be held so please make sure you are on time to jump.

Cross country - will run in back number order. If you have multiple horses in the same class, please speak with the start marshal to ask if you could run your first horse earlier. The course will be open for walking late Friday afternoon, once officials have signed off, we will post a note on our Facebook page when you are able to walk the course.

Prizegiving will take place 30mins after the TD has signed off results. Winner to be mounted in the main arena, all other placegetters please attend unmounted. We are unable to send out rosettes post show.

Yarding - upon arrival you will note that yards are clean with no bailing twine and the chain is closed. Chip is available. When you depart you must leave your yards clean and tidy. Any riders who leave messy or dirty yards will be charged a \$50 cleaning fee.

Muck bins - are provided please place only manure and hay in these.

Medics - If you have a fall on the weekend, no matter how minor you need to get checked by the onsite medic before you can remount. If you fail to get checked, you will be eliminated.

Farrier - onsite and available Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday mornings until 9am. Please pop up to the office to grab his number if required.

On Site Food - great options including Pizza, BBQ Boys plus Frankies Espresso Bar. Pizza and BBQ options are available for dinner from 5-7pm.
