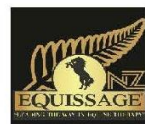
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CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - ALL CLASSES

Entry Restrictions & Conditions

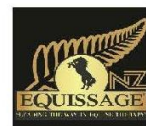
- All classes are run under ESNZ rules available on the ESNZ website (www.nzequestrian.org.nz).
- Ponies – may only enter one height category (excludes Equitation)
- Entries will be restricted to a maximum number of 5 classes per day (including Equitation but excluding warm up classes) per horse/pony
- Formal attire for all summer series classes unless directed by the Judge (not applicable to intro classes)
- Pony National Series – ponies may only enter the correct height related category. All ponies must have a current height certificate which can be requested for viewing by any show official. The height categories are as follows: **Cat A** - 133cm & under; **Cat B** - over 133cm & up to 143cm; and **Cat C** - over 143cm and up to & including 148cm.
- Pony riders can only compete in **one** pony equitation series class on any one day – either BOP & Waikato Show Hunter Groups 12 years & under Equitation National Series or Equissage NZ Pony Rider Equitation National Series. Equissage NZ Pony Rider Equitation National Series classes are open to any aged pony rider
- The Rising Star Series is open to those horses not jumping over 90cm for the duration of the show. Horses jumping over 90cm at the show are able to enter the Rising Star classes but are not eligible for Rising Star series points (but are eligible for HOYQ points and prize money).
- Prydes Greater Auckland Handy Hunter local series – run over one class per category per show. Points are awarded to combinations and will be awarded for 1st – 5th (Points: 6, 4, 3, 2, 1 respectively) as long as the score is 66% or higher. Ponies may only enter the correct height related category.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter, combine or cancel classes.
- All competitors enter at their own risk and must be familiar with the Health and Safety Policy
- Pony classes are for riders 17 years of age or younger as at 1 August 2025.
- All stallion riders and handlers must wear stallion armbands when mounted and handling their stallion
- All helmets must have a Yellow ESNZ/NZPCA tag. Helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.

Venue Rules

- No non-competing horses are allowed on the property, every horse that enters the property must be entered into at least one class
- Sorry **no dogs** allowed (even in cars/trucks). This will result in instant elimination
- No tying horses to fences. No leading from horse back (ponying)
- Curfew of 10pm, no access to arenas or office areas after this time – no loud music after this time
- Speed limit is 10km per hour at all times.

Yarding/Camping

- Yards and Camping are available for the duration of the show, please book yards at the time of entry
- Uncovered Yards: \$10 per horse per show (note; riders will need to bring their own gear to secure the yards as the yards do not have gates);
- Camping \$20 per truck/float per show
- Allocated yarding details will be emailed to you, there will also be a copy available on site
- All yarded equines are to have their name; the name of the person responsible and the phone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rugs (as per Jumping Rules 200.7.1)





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- You must use your allocated yard, please leave it clean (no dung or hay). Yards will be checked prior and post the show and a cleaning fee of \$25 will be charged to clean out any yards left with dung or hay
- Report any damage to the SHW committee/office

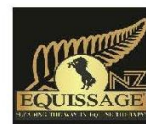

- Fees to be included with Entry:**
 - COMPULSORY Ground Fee \$40.00 per horse/pony
 - COMPULSORY SHW Administration & Medic Fee \$15 per horse/pony
 - COMPULSORY ESNZ Jumping Levy \$8.50 per horse/pony
 - COMPULSORY Evo Events online fees
 - If applicable – Flexi-Start Fees
 - If applicable – Yarding and/or camping fees
 - Class Entry Fees (including warm up rounds)
- All entries received after the closing date for entries (including entries on the day) will incur a \$25 penalty (note this does not include class changes or additional classes)
- Scratchings** – before Close of Entry, full refund of all fees except online and administration fees. After close of entries, scratchings must be accompanied by a medical or veterinary certificate prior to the class commencement for a refund of 75% of entry, ground, yard and accommodation fees. Please note that Online, administration, medic, and any late fees are non-refundable. Scratchings by email to: showhunterwaitemata@gmail.com.

- Only one warm up round per horse or pony

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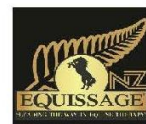
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- Riders require a full ESNZ Annual Membership to enter any Registered Classes (ie; summer series classes at this show).
- Riders will require a minimum of a casual day membership (\$16.30) to enter any Have-A-Go (Intro) classes at this show.
- Horses/Ponies competing in the Have-A-Go (Intro) classes are not required to pay any registration fees
- To enter any Registered Classes unregistered horses/ponies (or horses/ponies registered with ESNZ with no annual discipline start):
 - **WITHOUT** current ESNZ Equine Registration - \$30.15 (includes \$25 Flexi-Start)
 - **WITH** current ESNZ Equine Registration but no Jumping/Show Hunter Discipline Start - \$25 Flexi-Start
 - Are restricted to 1.10m and under. Ponies are restricted to 1.00m and under
 - Are not eligible for HOYQ Points (but eligible for Prize Money) or to start in Series Classes.

Prize Money - Summer Series Classes

- Prize money will be paid out via direct credit after the show to the bank account listed on your Evo Events account (less any monies owed to Show Hunter Waitemata if applicable). Please make sure your bank account details on Evo Events are up-to-date.
- Prize money will be paid providing a qualifying score of 66% or above is achieved
- Additional prize money may be paid out per class at the discretion of the committee.





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2025 - 2026 SHOW HUNTER WAITEMATA SUMMER SERIES - DETAILS

Summer Series Show Dates: 29th & 30th November 2025; 1 February 2026; and 28th February & 1 March 2026

Open to all Horses and Ponies competing in the Waitemata Summer Series. Presentations will be mounted on 1st March 2026. Overall series points will be allocated to the top three rounds per day. Points will be awarded for 1st – 5th (Points: 6, 4, 3, 2, 1 respectively) as long as the score is 66% or higher. In the case of any equal points, the overall placings will be determined by the number of first placings etc.

Series Prizes:

Horselands Cat A Pony – Most points accumulated in Category A Classes excluding Equitation

Horselands Cat B Pony – Most points accumulated in Category B Classes excluding Equitation

Horselands Cat C Pony – Most points accumulated in Category C Classes excluding Equitation

Burger King Rising Star Horse – Most points accumulated in Rising Star Horse Classes

Stirrups Equestrian Open Horse – Most points accumulated in Open Horse Classes excluding Equitation & Rising Star Classes

Prizes will be awarded to all of the above Series as follows:

- Champion Rug & Sash
- Reserve Champion Sash & Prize

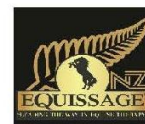
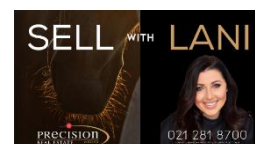


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HEALTH & SAFETY

Show Hunter Waitemata is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, supporters and spectators.

We will take all practicable steps by:

- providing a safe event, safe equipment and proper materials
- identifying and monitoring risks and hazards and using the risk management hierarchy of controls: eliminate, isolate or minimize
- insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- complying with all H&S legislation, regulations and codes of practice.

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, ALL PEOPLE AT THE EVENT need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy.

COMPETITORS will be responsible for themselves at **ALL times** by observing safe practices and rules/instructions relating to their competition.

Every person involved in an event run by Show Hunter Waitemata is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- being involved in the event health and safety system
- following correct procedures
- safe and proper use of equipment
- wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required
- reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible
- ensuring **ALL** accidents and incidents are reported to the Health and Safety Officer at the Office
- helping new participants, helpers and visitors to understand the right safety procedures and why they exist
- **informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns, accidents, incidents or injuries**
- keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

In the case of a fall of a rider and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, the practice arena, or elsewhere on the grounds of the event, the rider **MUST** be checked by the event's medical service and the check recorded on the rider's event medical check card before a rider is permitted to take part in any further rounds or competition at the event. The card must remain with the rider and be presented to the gate steward or ground committee before the rider continues to compete. The horse must be cleared by a Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if a Veterinarian is not available, before the horse is permitted to take part in any further rounds or competition at the event.

Show Hunter Waitemata complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be removed from the event. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's well-being, assesses the rider and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if there is any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the Blue Card Process. The ESNZ Blue Card Process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care.
