YARDING

Please note that **yarding is COMPULSORY** and will be allocated and charged on entry. All horses must be yarded unless being ridden under saddle. Only park in front of the A block yards if you are allocated a yard there. Please only use your allocated yard. If there is a problem with your yard, please let the office know and we will allocate you a new one. All yards must be mucked out and left clean on your exit. A cleaning fee of \$25 will be charged for yards left dirty.

Conditions of Entry:

1. Event is run under ESNZ Rules.
2. It is the rider's responsibility to read these conditions of entry and abide by all rules.
3. The event runs between 8.00am and 5pm on 22nd February 2026..
4. **Entries close Wednesday 11th February 2026** at midnight. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz
5. Payments must be made by Polipay when entering. If you cannot pay by that method, payment can be made by manual internet banking immediately into Dressage Tauranga bank account Dressage Tauranga Group – 03 0445 0178098 00.
6. Entries will not be accepted without full entry fees paid. **YOU WILL NOT BE PUT IN THE DRAW UNTIL FEES ARE PAID IN FULL BY CLOSE OF ENTRIES.** It is your responsibility to pay fees on time. A late payment fee of \$10 will be added if fees are not paid IN FULL prior to close of entries.
7. **Arena set up is 3pm on Saturday 21st February 2026. We would appreciate as many people to assist with this as possible to make it easier on everyone. Remember we are doing this so that YOU can ride.**
8. All riders must wear approved helmets that meet the ESNZ safety standards and have a **YELLOW TAG**. Any riders not wearing a helmet with a yellow tag will not be permitted to ride. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure their helmet is correct.
9. Maximum of 3 tests per horse/pony. Ponies may compete against horses in all classes. Maximum of 2 horses / ponies per rider.
10. Riders entered in the under 16 years class must have been 16 years old or younger as at close of entries.
11. **ESNZ membership:** All entered riders must be current ESNZ members on the day of competition whether this is a full competition membership or an introductory membership. Causal day memberships can be purchased with your entry. Please include this on your entry.
12. **REFUNDS:** If your scratching is received before close of entries, a full refund will be given, less compulsory Evo Events fees. After close of entries, all other fees less the online entry fee and admin fee will be refunded with a vet, farrier or doctors' certificate. These will be accepted up to 7 days after the event. Acceptance of these outside the above timeframes are entirely at the OC's discretion.
13. Please notify scratching dressagetauranga@gmail.com. **Please do not contact the show secretary via any other means.**
14. **Lead rein classes** – riders must be 10 years and under and are not to have competed in any off-lead rein competitions prior to the start of the show.
15. Only horses entered are permitted to be on the grounds.
16. **ID numbers:** All horses must wear identification numbers which will either be your registered number or a number will be allocated and must be collected from the office prior to competing. These are to be worn on the saddle blanket for the duration of the show and must be returned at the end of the event.
17. **ID tags:** All horses must wear ID tags (with name and contact cell number) at all times while on the grounds when not competing. These will be checked during the event.
18. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and the organising committee reserves the right to wait list entries. Accepted late entries will incur a \$10 fee per horse.
19. **Cancellation / postponement:** If the day is cancelled or postponed, check the website and our Facebook page for cancellation. Notice will be posted by 2pm prior. If the event is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded in full less the compulsory Evo Events fee. If the event is postponed, entry fees will be refunded in full less the compulsory Evo Events fee if you cannot make the new date allocated.
20. **Dogs:** are allowed on the grounds but must be on a lead at all times and are not permitted near competition areas (in the premier arena area and on the arena side of the oval).

21. No liability will be accepted in the event of an accident to horse, rider, spectator or property. Riders compete at their own risk. By entering the show, riders acknowledge that they accept all risks.
22. **All falls and incidents that occur on the grounds during the event must be reported to the show office immediately regardless of the seriousness. All suspected concussions **MUST** be reported to ESNZ according to their concussion policy.** This event is subject to the ESNZ concussion policy:

23. Classes may be cancelled or merged if there are insufficient entries.
24. Equal Placings: See DNZ Rule, article 465. In the case of equality, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
25. For riders riding the same horse or pony, only the first rider in time to compete may be eligible for placings. The second in time to ride must ride HC.
26. Our official photographer for the day is **Kaitlyn Perry Photography**. Any other photographers require the permission of the organising committee to attend.
27. There is to be absolutely no jumping of any jumps on the grounds for the duration of the show. Any riders found to be doing so will be eliminated from the competition and asked to leave.

Health and Safety Policy

Dressage Tauranga is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.

1. All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Tauranga Health & Safety Policy and the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
2. Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
3. Any incident or near miss must be reported to the event office and an incident form completed.
4. Any hazards identified must be reported to the event office.
5. Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and follow event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.

By entering this event, as part of the entry process, you acknowledge that you agree to the rules and health & safety requirements of an event.

VIVANT EQUI DRESSAGE TAURANGA MEMBERS POINTS SERIES

This series is run over all ribbon days and registered shows for the 2025/26 season.
