All fees are due to be paid at time of entry in full. Unpaid entries will not be entered into the event.

EVENT CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION:

- All riders to supply a jump judge. This is a condition of entry, and entry will not be accepted without a Jump judge. Please enter in the Volunteers section.**
- Event is run under Eventing NZ rules; see Annex 5 for Pony Club rules. Please see NZPCA section for gear check rules <http://www.nzequestrian.org.nz>
- Once a class is full or you are a late entry, you may be waitlisted until scratchings occur.
- Unpaid entries on 16th March 2026 will not be put in the draw and waitlisted if event is full. Late entry fee of \$20 per horse will apply.
- WITHDRAWALS AND SUBSTITUTIONS (530)**
Notifications of withdrawal from an event must be given to the Event Secretary via Evo Events prior to the commencement of the event. If a Horse is withdrawn prior to the closing date for entries, the entry fee will be refunded in full. There will be no refund for a withdrawal made within 48 hours of the commencement of the event except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Organising Committee. If the withdrawal is made in writing after the closing date for entries and more than 48 hours before the commencement of the event, the entry fee will be refunded less 20% without a Veterinary or Medical Certificate being required.
- In case of event cancellation due to extreme weather, refunds will be made minus EE fees.
- The organising committee reserve the right to alter conditions, schedule and timetable. Classes may be Split/combined and all times will be approximate.
- Riders (Parent/Guardian) by submitting an entry means you will abide by the conditions of entry.
- Any rider who has suffered a concussion 3 weeks prior to this event may not compete without medical Clearance.
- Safety approved yellow tagged helmets must be worn when mounted. Tagged Safety approved back protectors for XC phase.

- 11.** Protests must be submitted to the event secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident and accompanied by \$50 which will be returned if protest upheld.
- 12.** Limited yarding/camping at grounds. Priority will be given to those travelling from out of the region and then in order of entry and payment.
- 13.** NO DOGS –no exceptions ...will result in rider elimination.
- 14.** Grounds closed for XC schooling from 8pm 8th March 2026 until 7am 23rd March 2026.
- 15.** Ribbons/ Prizes can be collected from the clubrooms 30 minutes after the official results are posted.
- 16.** While competing, Riders must wear their draw number both on their front and on their back during all Tests and while schooling.

Athletes must ensure that back numbers are not obscured by hair.

At all times while a Horse is on the event grounds (including being ridden, stabled/yarded, hacking or grazing) it is compulsory for a personal identification tag (an engraved metal disc or cattle ear tag are examples) with owner or riders name and cell phone number OR the draw number to be worn by the horse for the purposes of identification. A personal ID tag may be replaced by a bridle number while competing. These numbers must be displayed on the near (left) side of the horse.
