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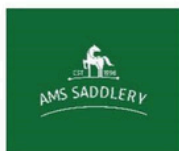

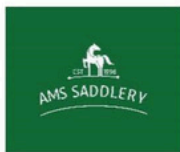

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries will only be accepted with full payment on at the time of finalising entry on Evo Events.
- Entries will not be accepted, until Direct credit payments have been received. MUST have SURNAME and SJ as reference.
- All riders compete at their own risk.
- All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership.
- All classes run under current ESNZ rules & Series classes as per Series conditions.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the programme
- Formal dress code; otherwise at the committees discretion.

- Entries may be limited in some classes and places will be offered on a first paid basis. Those not accepted into a class will be eligible for a full refund of entry fees for that class.
- All riders must have the correctly tagged helmet (yellow) as per ESNZ Rules.
- Pony Club **Class (Class 27)**; Rider to be 21 years or younger on the day. – Rider to have not competed 1.10 and above on a horse / Pony. Riders must be a current pony club member. This class is open to Ponies and Hacks.
- Class 6 – This show is part of the Main-Events 1.10m Series. Placings in 1.10m classes may contribute towards end-of-season jackpot prize draws. Visit www.main-events.com for more info.

LEVIES & FEES

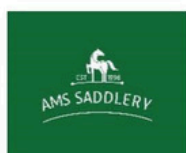
These fees are for the entire duration of the show

SCRATCHINGS:

Refunds:

- Entry fee refunded if notified before 8am Tuesday 10th March with doctor/vet certificate.
- Full yarding/camping fee included if notified by 8am 18th November.

All other refunds at OC discretion.

Accounts not paid prior to close of entry will still be charged if scratched/ or a no show without paying. Online entry fee is non-refundable irrespective of when scratching.

REFUNDS: Refunds will be paid electronically following the completion of the show, to the bank account nominated in your Equestrian Entries account.

PRIZE MONEY: All prizemoney and refunds will be paid out electronically, to your bank account and the person who made the entry. Bank accounts must be verified online with Evo Events.

For Series classes this show will pay prize money to 6th place regardless of the number of penalties in the first round.

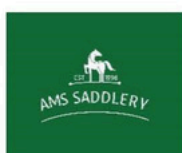
DOGS: are welcome at PPC but must be on a leash at all times – failure to comply could result in rider being eliminated.
