ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & EVENT T&Cs

DEFINITIONS & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- **LEAD REIN** is for those combinations who are on lead and must compete on lead all day.
- **KINDY** is for those combinations who have not competed in any novice event or class in any discipline and are under the age of 11 years old.
- **NOVICE** is a combination which has:
 1. Not won a red ribbon at an A&P or NZSHA Council Show in any class
 2. Not won a Maiden or Open class at any ribbon day
 3. Not won a Champion on the Flat or Jumping in any Novice Ring
- **MASTERS** refers to all riders 21 years and over. All Masters participants must compete in the Masters Ring
- **SUPREME CHAMPION** class is those who have won champion in each ring respectively to compete together to win supreme champion on the flat. The judges will be decided from the pool of judges that are there on the day.

EVENT RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries online via Evo Events
- Entries close at 5pm on Thursday 2 April 2026.
- Payments not received by 2nd April will have late fees applied. Riders will not be able to compete if payment has not been received.
- Entry Fee \$50 per combination for Full Day or \$35 per combination for Half Day.
- Classes are judged according the ESNZ and NZPCA Rules.
- Riders must wear yellow tagged approved safety helmets. Safety vests are optional for jumping classes.
- Riders ride at their own risk.
- Event starts at 10am. Afternoon start times intended as a guide only and may vary based on entry numbers.
- Classes will run in class order; Gate Stewards will announce classes, but may not call riders by name. Please be prepared for the classes you have entered.
- No refunds without a vet or doctors certificate.
- Plaiting / Jackets optional, tidy appearance is essential.
- No jumping of Cross Country jumps. The Cross Country course will be closed on Event Day.
- No dogs during competitions please.
