

Parking / Camping at the NEC Taupo

Effective immediately for ALL users of the NEC Taupo

The NEC is bound by many laws and regulations, one of which is the Camping-Grounds Regulations 1985 - Version as at 15 November 2021

Whilst we have some exemptions, we are not exempt from Regulation 9 (1) (f) as follows

9 General standards (1) (f)

“The camping ground shall be provided with safeguards against fire, and means of escape in case of fire, to the satisfaction of the local authority.”

To meet this regulation FENZ & other emergency services must have clear access to ALL horse trucks etc that are used for accommodation

Remember stables, covered yards etc are full of hay, shavings and other combustible materials Vehicles not used for accommodation should be parked well away from any yard, covered or open. FENZ must have the quickest and safest route to the inside of a truck in the case of an emergency - EG fire, Cardiac arrest,

Parking ramps to the yards pose huge obstacles for FENZ access, ramps facing the road give ease of access in the event of any emergency

To achieve this within the parameters of the various legislations the following will now apply



Parking Requirements:

- **All trucks and floats must be parked nose-in toward the yards, 3 meters back from the yards**
- **New Covered Yards (#500 block):** Park nose to the yards, ramps facing the road.
- **The Strip (Old Covered Yards):** Park nose to the pipe yards, ramps to the road
- **Grass area before the Walled Yards (muck heap end):** ◦ Near the hedge: ramps must face the hedge (leave room to unload and for FENZ access). ◦ Roadside: ramps must face the road, forming two nose-to-nose rows.



Safety Reminders:

- **No unhitched trailers** near the #500 yards. Please relocate them to the roadside hedge or far camping area.
- **Do not tie horses to unhitched floats**
- **Tents** may only be erected in the **grass area behind the cabins**, away from all yards.
