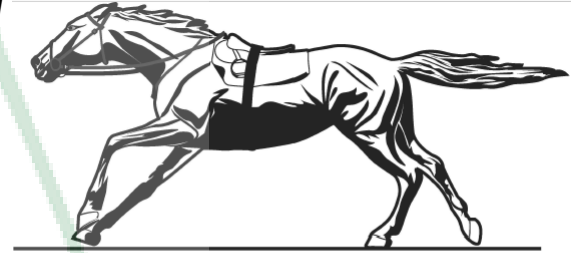

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Organising Committee reserves its rights, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 610 & 611
2. Article 610 – **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** Neither the Organiser of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to Horses, owners, Athletes, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents & accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.
3. All classes will be run under all applicable FEI Rules & Regulations or ESNZ Eventing Rules effective 1 August 2025. All riders should consult the rules for information regarding qualifications, including MER's, qualifying periods & deadlines. If entering the CCN1*-L please ensure you know the difference in the rules between CCN105 & CCN1*.
4. Excessive entries & balloting as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 645
5. All entries will be charged a non-refundable Administration Fee. Accommodation requirements are to be completed online with entries -www.evoevents.co.nz.
6. All fees are payable by POLi Pay, Bank Account for Internet Banking WILD RIDERS 12-3093-0344542-00. PLEASE PUT **SURNAME of COMPETITOR** ON THE PAYMENT. If paying by credit card with PayPal a 3.8% transaction charge will be automatically applied when paying by PayPal. Transaction charges are non-refundable.
7. All horses in classes 1 are required to have an FEI passport (Purple book). All horses in classes 2-4 are required to have either a FEI passport (purple) or an Official ESNZ Identification book (orange) – FEI Article 137
8. **COMPETITORS** - Memberships & Registration conditions: (See Annex below)
 - a. Classes 1 - 3 riders & horses must be registered with the FEI before their entries can be accepted, See Article 500 2.4
 - b. Classes 1 - 7 - Horses & Riders must have full membership & full equine registration with ESNZ. Class 8 -10 - Riders not members of ESNZ can pay a \$16.30 Casual Membership fee.
 - c. Class 8 - 10 - Horses not registered with ESNZ can pay a \$5.15 Casual Equine Registration fee.
9. All horses in FEI CCI-L classes 1-3 must stay on the grounds. It is recommended that those in class 4 - CCN-L 1* stay on the grounds, however not compulsory.
10. **Arrival inspections** (ID & temperature checks) – ALL Horses in FEI & CCI-L classes 1 – 4 must be presented for the arrival inspection. Times for this will be available in your Rider Notes. CCI4* must have a FEI Passport; CCI3* & CCI2* Must have either an FEI Passport or an ESNZ ID Book; CCN1* Must have ID Papers or ESNZ ID Book. Any horses travelling with these horses that are in classes 5-11 or YEH & are stabled with, will have to have a manual record of temperatures taken & kept for the same as FEI horses. These horses will also be subject to the relevant stabling rules & announcements.
11. **Horse inspections** (Trot up) Thursday & Sunday for classes 1-4. Times will be in your Rider Notes.
12. **Late payments** - Unpaid entries at date entry closing are subject to pay the compulsory fees once entered. Unpaid/un-activated entries will incur late fee of \$100 if entry is activated by late payment after the close of entries.
13. **Scratchings/Refunds/Prize Money**. - All scratchings are to be done through Evo Events. Scratching must be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 646. **REFUNDS:** Riders in FEI & Long Format, classes 1 to 4 scratching from the event 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 12th May 2026) will be entitled to a 50% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate. Riders in National classes 5 to 11, scratching from the event 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 12th May 2026) will be entitled to an 80% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate. Queries & requests for refunds including vet & medical certificates need to be emailed to the secretary before 20th May 2026 to qualify for refund. Refunds will be processed between the completion of the event & 30th June 2026. No refunds will be investigated or paid after this date. In the event of cancellation or amendment, a minimum of 50% of entry fees will be refunded. Or at OC discretion.
14. **Non Qualifiers** – All fees for combinations not meeting the qualification requirements will be refunded LESS any non-refundable fees.
15. **LoveRacing.NZ classes:** Restricted to NZ or Australian Thoroughbred's only. Must have Breeding on Evo Events. Where possible, please include old Racing Name & Brands. CCN80 class - combinations not to have competed CCN95 or above – CCN95 class – combinations not to have competed CCN105 or above.
16. **Change of class**, horses, or riders in classes 1-4 will NOT be accepted from Monday 11th May 2026. Any decisions other than that of the FEI to change after this date will result in the entry being scratched from the event.
17. **Double Entry** - \$10, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 644.
18. **Qualifications** (MERs)–See the ESNZ Eventing website/resources/riders.
19. **Yards** - All yards are to be left clean & free of hay. Riders will be fined \$100 per yard if your allocated yards are left in an unacceptable condition. If you are leaving early & you would like your yard checked before you leave, please contact the

stable manager before you depart, if unavailable, take a photo & email to Secretary immediately. Please report any damaged yards to the stable manager throughout the event.

20. **DOGS** - must be on a leash (no longer than 5m) at all times & to be under control of a suitable person. Failure to comply will result in a fine for the owner & or dog being removed from the grounds. No dogs in the Indoor Facility. Please confine dogs to the XC & Truck Park areas – not the Warm-up or Competition Areas. All proceeds to Fiber Fresh NEC Taupo - Minimum fine per offence \$50.
21. The OC reserves the right to substitute prize money with product of equal or greater value – Article 611. All entry fees & prize money listed in this schedule include GST. Additional prize money paid in accordance with ESNZ rules. Unless otherwise notified, prizemoney will be paid out in full (subject to IRD deductions) to the Rider by Direct Credit to the Bank Account nominated on MY ACCOUNT in Evo Events entry system, no later than 30th June 2026 – subject to the results of testing for Clean Sport.
22. Individual prizes more than \$500 will have withholding tax deducted at the rate of 20% provided a correctly completed IR330 is completed prior to receiving the prize money, otherwise at the relevant no declaration rate of 45%. Individual circumstances do vary. Evo Events will work with you to ensure the tax is appropriate for your circumstance, rules vary for Limited Liability, Partnerships & Trusts. See ESNZ Eventing Articles 619 & 620.
23. Eventing NZ Style Prize will be awarded over classes 6-11.

ADDITIONAL TROPHIES:

- Silver Spurs Trophy - Inter-Island teams' competition.
- Caseley Trophy - best presented horse over the entire competition – judged by a mystery judge.
- Charlton Stud Prize - best performed mare over the entire competition.
- NZPCA Award. Rosette & rug to the highest placed Pony Club rider at the event. Pony Club riders must nominate & complete their PC information in their Evo Events account to be eligible for this award. The winner will be calculated under the Swarbrick Scale. The NZPCA Rally Rule applies.

NZ WARBLOOD ASSOCIATION YOUNG EVENT HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

1. Horse to be four or five years old at date of final based on foaling date 1 August.
2. Rider to be 15 years old or over.
3. Horse to be 15hh or over & ridden in a snaffle bridle.
4. Depending on timetabling a limit of 20 horses may be required. Minimum of 5 x 4-year-olds will be accepted.
5. In the event entries need to be limited the following conditions will apply, horses will be balloted based on the highest performance record from 1st August 2025
 - a. 4 year olds performance at a CCN80 or ESNZ express events
 - b. 5 year olds performance at a ESNZ Eventing CCN95 or ESNZ express events
 - c. All remaining unqualified horses will be waitlisted & accepted if space allows
6. Excessive entries not accepted into the YEH class entry fees will be refunded entry fee, excluding the online entry fee.
7. Format of the Competition:
 - a. Each of the 4 tests has an individual judge.
 - b. The judges look for an athletic, loose moving horse with a promising jumping technique which, with correct training, should make a good event horse. Martingales & boots are optional but only minimal time allowed for change of gear will be allowed for change of tack between sections.
 - i. Simple dressage test. Emphasis on paces & trainability, No boots are martingales.
 - ii. Jumping. Approx 10-12 fences, mix of Show jumps & Cross-Country fences, Show jumps not to exceed 1 metre & cross country jumps not to exceed 95cm.

PLEASE NOTE THAT SINCE THERE ARE CROSS COUNTRY JUMPS INVOLVED IN THIS CLASS A BACK PROTECTOR MUST BE WORN.

- iii. Gallop to be suitable for XC, and
 - iv. Movement, Conformation & Suitability of Type.
8. At the end of this judging the top 5 horses on points will compete in front of all the judges who will decide the final placings. Points will not carry through, although in the event of a tie, points from the qualifying round will decide the winner. Horses will be asked to complete up to a 2-minute freestyle dressage display followed by 5-6 jumps.
9. Dressage test to be found at the back of the schedule. Thank you for your entry into the Young Event Horse Class.
10. In a move to increase the integrity of this competition & to align with ESNZ Eventing rules all horses **MUST** have breed papers or a passport to prove not only the pedigree, but also the year of birth of your horse & have this recorded at ESNZ .
 - i. If you are competing a thoroughbred, simply send in a printout from Studbook | Stud Book (loveracing.nz)
 - ii. If you are competing on a warmblood horse & do not have papers please contact either the NZWA or the NZ Hanoverian Society get papers for this horse.
 - iii. If you are competing a crossbred you can contact www.sphanz.co.nz to gain a passport that way, & if your horse is a specific non-warmblood breed (eg Irish Sport Horse) please contact the relevant breed organisation.
 - iv. We are sure you will agree that ensuring all the pedigree information on each horse is correct & the breeder of your horse is recognised is an important step forward in promoting these young event horse classes.
