The rider criteria for

You must have not competed/posted a score at 10cm or higher in the class you wish to enter, if posted a score this class/event isn't for you. The 50, 60 and 70 classes; you can't have posted 2 scores 10cm's or higher than that height you enter, this event is for WAPC grassroots riders only. The final decision is up to Club DC/Head Coach on above rules.

This will be up the club to follow through as well as enter the team/s, spot checks will be done on riders
No dispensation for riders

Drinks and Food: has been booked and will be available more info closer to the event.

Events: 2 Phase, TAM5 and Accumulator

50cm and 60 cm is call back jump off for TAM5 (this year each height has their own ring)

70cm and 80cm is instant jump off for TAM5 (shared rings)

The riders running order will found on Evo Events under their class, please follow this draw

Class placings ribbons will be given out in our prize giving area, by your judge, as will overall team rosettes and Trophy, which will be unmounted.

ALL FALLS MUST BE SEEN BY THE MEDIC, EVEN AT THE PRACTICE FENCE

Your club will be given a job either gate and rail duty, we run this the same for North Island Show Jump Champs also, we know everyone wants to help and support their riders, but we will give you plenty of time to work out a roster system to work around who and when it's your clubs turn is so you can work out your own roster, thank you in advance 😊

Job description for above duties

Gate: you are given a clipboard with riders draw order, you call out their names are get them ready to go into the ring next, make sure the rider remembers to tell the judge their name

Rail duty: you rebuild the knocked down jumps and/or put back up the knocked down poles as they were, you stand outside the ring,

Managers notes: - these will be talked about at the briefing

- **Teams are entered though YOUR club not individually, part teams welcome and encouraged**
- **You must abide by the NZPCA Fair Play Charter**

- **The 5 rally rule is a must on pony/horse you are riding**
- **If your team has any questions only send team manager to office**
- **Managers are responsible for gear checks,**
- **Plan is to have a rider in the ring and another rider ready to enter the ring just as the rider jumping is nearing the end of their round (this is the keep to a running time) and remind your riders to give their name to the judge**
- **Full PC riding attire when walking the course – no walking over jumps**
- **Protests to be in writing, accompanied with \$50.00, which will be returned to you if protest is upheld**
- **Outside assistance is allowed in show jumping (FYI not for eventing show jumping)**
- **Acknowledge/salute the judge after she rings YOUR start bell**
- **4 riders in warm up ring at same time – no more**
- **Use of whip/spurs rules not excessive use, no exceptions, whip must have flap and be regulation length for jumping**
- **Overall Prize giving will be unmounted**
- **No onsite farrier or vet**
- **Helmets yellow tags must be worn**
- **Jewellery: If riders are wearing jewellery, it must be worn discretely and safely**
- **Chaps we will allow suede chaps for this event as we feel they will be in use, however please make your riders/parents are familiar with rule 16.8 c. Two-piece boots / gaiters i. Two-piece boots - must principally be made of matching smooth full grain leather, so that when the rider is mounted in the saddle, the visible part of the gaiter resembles as closely as possible leather riding boots. ii. Gaiters made of suede or any other materials are not allowed, exception - rallies.**
- **Job roster as above and please assist the course builder with course changes and heights going up and down**
- **Please assist with packing up at end of competition**
- **Keep your riders fed and watered along with their pony's**
- **Enjoy the day**

Waikato Area Pony Club is running this event as we want to give our up-and-coming grassroots riders an event like North Island Show Jump Champs, show jumping for their Club as well as their team at a height they are currently comfortable jumping – we hope you have an enjoyable and fun competition; we thank you for your support and assistance with running this event
