ENTRY FEES: (includes ESNZ Levy) Ribbons 1st to 4th

Class Entry	\$15 per class
Admin fee/Training Levy:	\$12 per horse
Ground/Arena fee:	\$20 per horse
Open Yard	\$10 per horse per day/night
Stables/Covered yards	\$15 per horse per day/night
Camping (without power)	\$12 per vehicle per day/night.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – IT IS THE RIDERS RESPONSIBILITY TO BE AWARE OF ALL RULES AND CONDITIONS.

1. All classes run under ESNZ Rules.
2. Entries Close as per the date on page 1 showing schedule of classes. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz. Please note Entries may close early if numbers reach capacity. Priority will be given to those who have entered and paid. Entry fees must be paid by closing date to be included in draw. In the event the OC needs to close entries prior to the closing date, full payment is required within 2 working days of closing or entry will be moved to the waitlist.
3. Entries will not be accepted without full payment of all fees. Entries without the correct/current ESNZ registration will not be accepted.
4. Graded Riders must be Full ESNZ members. Horses must be registered with ESNZ and have either an annual dressage start or pay DNZ Flexi Start \$5 per class up to level 4, \$10 per test levels 5 - 9.
5. Under ESNZ membership rules all riders competing must be members of ESNZ, including for Intro/Unregistered classes. For this you need to register under a Casual or Introductory Membership. Go to www.nzequestrian.org.nz and sign up. Once you have registered you can enter.
6. For late entry requests please contact the Event Secretary (tkidressageevents@gmail.com). Late entries may be wait-listed. Accepted late entries will incur a \$20 penalty per horse, payable before riding on the day. **No class changes after close of entries.**
7. Please pay by PoliPay or Internet banking – Dressage Taranaki, Tournament A/c - 15-3952-0378418-02. Please use your name & Month of Show as reference e.g. "May Show".
8. Maximum of 2 tests per horse/pony per day. Maximum of 5 tests per rider. Ponies may compete against horses in all classes. One rider per horse/pony.
9. There is no arena familiarisation offered at these events. If you wish to use the venue the day prior you must book and pay the venue owner.
10. All horses must wear ID tags (with name and contact cell phone number) at all times on the grounds when not competing.
11. Draw will be available on www.evoevents.co.nz.
12. If due to weather forecast the show is cancelled, riders will be sent email messages or text messages where possible. Please ensure a contact phone number/email address is provided for this purpose. Cancellation will also be on the DT Facebook page – it is the riders responsibility to check if unsure.
13. Please notify scratchings via Evo Events or email tkidressageevents@gmail.com. Applications for refunds with a Vet, Farrier, or Doctors Certificate, will be accepted up to 7 days after the event. Amount of Refund is calculated after deduction of the online fees and the Administration Fee. Any refunds are paid at the discretion of the OC. Credits may be given at discretion of OC.
14. No Liability will be accepted by Dressage Taranaki in the event of any accident or injury to horse, rider, spectator or property. A copy of the Egmont A&P Association's Health & Safety policy is available at the Egmont A&P office and must be adhered to. On arrival please read the Hazard Identification Notice at the gate. All riders must wear a yellow tagged helmet.
15. Protests must be lodged with the secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the results with a payment of the \$50 protest fee. The fee is refunded if the protest is upheld.

16. Any horses brought to the event but not competing must be registered with the convener prior to the event and a Ground & Yard Fee paid.
17. All yards and areas around floats & trucks must be left clean & tidy. Please place any hay/sawdust/manure etc in the bins designated for this. Do not bring your own shavings – use those provided.
18. Classes may be combined/cancelled if there are insufficient entries.
19. Any dogs must be on leashes AT ALL TIMES and are only permitted in the truck park area.
20. ALL riders are asked to be available to help at this show. Please indicate your preferred task when making your entry, tasks will be allocated once the Draw has been done.
21. Any equine therapists (e.g. physio, Bowen, Equissage etc) who intend treating horses at this event (privately or commercially) MUST notify the Show Secretary prior to the event and must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event. Riders with their own personal systems (eg Equissage, Cyclossage etc) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems while at the venue for this event.

AWARDS & CHAMPIONSHIPS

Riders must have competed in at least two of the three days to qualify for any awards.

On Event #3 - only B tests count towards individual series at Intro, Prelim, Elem, Medium and Adv Medium levels plus Advanced class 13, Small Tour class 14, Medium Tour class 15, Big Tour class 16 and Para class 17.

DELUXE ROSETTES FOR ALL SERIES WINNERS

Points based on 10 points for 1st place, 8 points for 2nd place, 6 points for 3rd place, 4 points for 4th place, 2 points for 5th place, and 1 point for 6th place. Combinations must receive over 57% to be eligible to gain points.
