CONDITIONS OF ENTRY, RULES & OTHER INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

- entries to be made online at www.evoevents.co.nz . Internet banking only available - **02-0655-0122340-000 (Flaxmere Pony Club)** - include rider's name and class as reference. Only fully paid entries will be included in the draw
- entry numbers will be restricted to 90 across all classes. Riders will be waitlisted once the 90 entries is reached
- no phone or email entries accepted and no late entries
- entries are open to Pony Club and non-Pony Club members. Non-Pony Club members must sign the agreement for casual membership of NZPCA on the day
- horses and riders are not required to be members of ESNZ
- all competitors must provide next of kin contact details to the Event Secretary prior to the event, as per Article 634 - Athletes Welfare. See 'My Account' page of EvoEvents. Please note that if a rider has a current medical condition, they must wear a medical armband
- all riders must supply a cross country fence judge. The name and mobile number of the volunteer is to be entered on EvoEvents when entering event
- withdrawals—refunds less \$TBC (booking and admin fee) if notified before 7pm on Sunday 9th August 2026. Refunds after this time will only be given if accompanied by a vet and/or doctor's certificate
- no postponement date. Entrants will be notified of cancellation via Facebook and email
- horses/ponies under four (4) years old are not able to enter
- stallions must be approved by the organising committee and the event TD. Permission will only be granted under strict guidelines. Contact convenor minimum two weeks in advance
- all competitors & spectators enter the grounds at their own risk
- the organising committee reserves the right to change the schedule, and classes may be combined if entries are insufficient, or split into further age groups if numbers permit
- NZPCA Gear Inspections – not required for class 1 (105); compulsory for cross country phase only for classes 2 and 3 (95). Compulsory for all phases for classes 4, 5, 6, 7 (65, 80). Failure to complete all appropriate gear inspections/checks will result in elimination
- dressage tests may be called for all classes
- no confrontation from riders or support people with judges or officials will be tolerated. Such action may lead to elimination
- prize giving will be at least 30 minutes after the final results are posted for each class
- protests must be made within 30 minutes of the posting of the final score and accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refunded if protest is upheld. The decision of the Judicial Committee is final and binding
- camping will be available on the grounds of the Hawke's Bay Equestrian Park
- dogs must be on a lead at all times and adhere to the rules set out on the Hawke's Bay Equestrian Park website
- jackets or Pony Club uniform to be worn for dressage and showjumping; cross country colours allowed, long or short sleeved
- printed back numbers will be provided and can be collected from the office from 1-4pm Saturday 15th August and from 7am Sunday 16th August. Riders will need to provide their own back number holder. Riders must provide a name and phone number of a cross country fence judge in order to receive their back number (if not provided at time of entry in Evo).
- NZPCA approved and tagged hard hats **MUST** be worn at all times while mounted—**HELMETS MUST BE YELLOW-TAGGED AS PER REGULATIONS FROM 1st AUGUST 2023**. Helmet must be properly fitting, securely fastened and correctly maintained
- NZPCA approved and tagged back protectors **MUST** be worn for cross country. Can be worn for other phases. Back protector must meet one of the following standards - BETA Level 3 2009, BETA Level 3 2018 or ASTM F1937, and must have the appropriate tag visible. If a rider wears an airbag style body protector, it must be worn over a permitted body protector
- first fall in any discipline or activity at any level means elimination and the rider must leave the competition course or arena. Any rider that falls must present to the medics immediately
- classes are run under **ESNZ Rules for Eventing**, Effective 1st August 2025 and **NZPCA General Regulations** August 2025. All riders and/or parents/guardians if under 18 should ensure they are familiar with and accept these rules. By entering online, you are agreeing to these rules and regulations
- whips – no whips allowed for dressage phase. Whips allowed for show jumping and cross country but must meet regulations set out in NZPCA – Eventing Gear Safety Inspection Checklist – Nov 24
- spurs optional for all phases but must meet regulations set out in NZPCA – Eventing Gear Safety Inspection Checklist – Nov 24

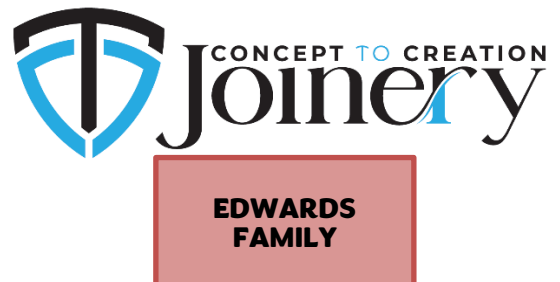
