Dressage Waikato Conditions

1. Class 1 and 2 (Training) must be ridden in a 20x40 arena. All other tests to be ridden in a 20 x 60 (unless Para grade dictates otherwise).
2. Champion and Reserve be awarded to the highest placed in each level. The two tests in your level will be used to determine points.
3. You must ride in your current competition level or above
4. Freestyles will be judged but not included in championships
5. You can enter as many tests as you want.
6. Callers can be used for all tests accordance with ESNZ rules.
7. Each test should be submitted on a separate you tube clip.
8. Each test costs a total of \$25 which includes the DNZ centre line levy.
9. Champion and Reserve at each level will be awarded at our AGM 21st July.

Before

You will need:

1. All tests should be ridden in a 60mx20m arena with letters correctly placed and clearly visible.
2. A patient videographer with a decent phone.
3. Horse or pony groomed to a high standard. (plaiting optional)
4. Appropriate rider clothing with correct helmet and footwear. (competition wear optional)
5. Lock up the dogs, cats, pigs and other spook hazards.

During

1. Videographer should be at C outside the arena (It could be helpful for your videographer to introduce horse and rider and state test before rider enters at C)

Eg *'Here we have Jilly Cooper riding Trigger about to enter and ride the Grand Prix'*

2. Ride the test from the entry to the final salute with videographer zooming in at appropriate times ensuring the horse is fully visible at all times.

3. Ride and video the test again if you feel like you need a 'do-over'.
4. Check video to see if it meets the criteria.

After

1. Upload your video to You Tube with your Full Name and Horse name in title and class number and test in subtitle. Email to dressagewaikatoshows@gmail.com

Terms and Conditions for ESNZ Affiliate Groups Dressage Online Competitions Using ESNZ/Dressage NZ Tests - May 2026 V1

Terms and Conditions

1. This event will use current ESNZ/Dressage NZ /FEI tests and will be judged in accordance with the applicable ESNZ/Dressage NZ dressage rules and judging principles, with the specific online-event conditions set out below.
2. This is a non-graded online competition. Results will not be recorded for grading purposes and will not count toward ESNZ/Dressage NZ national series, titles, leaderboards, annual awards or championship qualifications
3. Only current ESNZ/Dressage NZ or approved FEI dressage tests may be used. Tests must not be altered, shortened or modified unless approved by Dressage NZ.
4. Saddlery - must comply with the current ESNZ/DNZ Rule book Articles 420-430
5. Riders Dress – Riders must be wearing an ESNZ approved safety helmet, tidy dress and correct footwear.
6. Arena - Tests must be ridden in a safe, enclosed arena of the correct size for the test, with clearly visible letters. The arena should comply as closely as possible with ESNZ/Dressage NZ arena requirements.
7. The test must be recorded in one continuous take, without editing, pausing, splicing, filters or speed changes. The horse and rider must remain clearly visible throughout. Videos should be filmed from C. Zooming is encouraged, especially when the horse is at A end of the arena.
8. Outside assistance - No coaching or outside assistance is permitted during the recorded test.
9. The caller may read only the printed words of the test and must not coach, prompt, emphasise or otherwise assist the rider. Earphones or electronic communication devices must not be used during the recorded test.
10. Horse and rider welfare - The OC and/or judge may eliminate a test where the recording shows obvious lameness, blood, unsafe riding, a fall of horse or rider, dangerous conditions, significant distress, or any matter contrary to horse or rider welfare.
11. Risk waiver - By entering, riders acknowledge that they ride and record their test at their own risk. Riders are responsible for ensuring that the horse, rider, arena, surface, equipment and recording environment are safe and suitable.

12. Dressage Waikato, Dressage NZ, ESNZ, judges, officials and volunteers accept no liability for accident, injury, loss or damage except as required by law.
13. Publication and privacy - By entering, riders consent to results to be published (on whatever platform the OC uses), videos will not be viewed by anyone other than the appointed judge, without prior permission from the rider
