Conditions of Entry:

1. All classes are run under ESNZ Eventing Rules for Eventing and the appropriate NZPCA rules (Annex 5)
2. Riders (Parent/Guardian) by submitting an entry means you will abide by the conditions of entry. Springston Pony Club accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider or spectator.
3. Any rider who has suffered a concussion within 21 days of competition may not compete.
4. RIDING HELMETS shall be NZPCA approved **with a yellow tag and** are to be worn at all times while MOUNTED.
5. BACK PROTECTORS shall be NZPCA approved and are compulsory for the cross-country phases.
6. Gear check is required for all phases for 65 and 80cm; 95cm compulsory gear check for XC only with random checks for dressage and show jumping. Random gear check for all phases for 105 & 110cm.
7. Correct attire for all phases. Pony Club uniform acceptable. Long hair must be tied up, preferably in a hairnet.
8. Dressage tests can be called for the 65cm and 80cm classes only.
9. Whips are not permitted in the dressage phase, but spurs can be worn.
10. Disciplinary action will be taken if any person for abuse or serious mistreatment of a horse pony including excessive use of the whip or spurs.
11. Printed back numbers will NOT be provided. Please print and bring your own back numbers/back number holder.
12. Prize giving will be held approximately 30 minutes after the posting of final class scores providing there are no protests. Protests must be submitted to the event secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident and accompanied by \$50 which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
13. Prizes must be collected by the end of the event on Sunday, or they will be forfeited.
There will not be a mounted Prize Giving.



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14. Withdrawals, Substitutions and Refunds:

Notifications of withdrawal from an event must be given to the Event Secretary prior to the commencement of the event. If a Horse is withdrawn prior to the closing date for entries, the entry fee (minus admin & EE fee) will be refunded in full.

If a horse/rider is withdrawn after the closing date for entries and prior to the commencement of the event, 80% of the entry fee (minus admin & EE fee) will be refunded upon the production of a Veterinary or Medical Certificate.

Horses may be substituted up to the closing date for entries via EvoEvents.

Riders may be substituted up to the closing date for entries via EvoEvents.

Substitution of horses and riders after the closing date for entries and prior to the start of the event will be at the organising committee's discretion.

15. The event will be held wet or fine. In the unlikely event of a cancellation, for example, due to extreme weather conditions or a natural disaster, all riders will be notified via email and a notification will be posted on the Springston Pony Club Facebook page the night prior. In the event of cancellation, 75% of the entry fee (minus admin & EE fee) will be refunded.
16. First Aiders will be on site both days.
17. Horses must wear ID tags at all times-one on the halter when tied and one on the saddle when ridden. Include the horse's name, owner, and phone number.
18. A vet will be onsite for cross country on Saturday for the 105, 110, CCN105-S & CCN 2*-S classes and will be on call for the remainder of both days.
19. **No class changes will be accepted on the day.**
20. If eliminated on cross country you may NOT continue and must walk back.
21. If you have been eliminated in any jumping phase for stops or run outs, you cannot compete in the other jumping phase.
22. Elimination - a competitor may be eliminated at any stage of the competition by the ground jury for A: Dangerous Riding; B: in their opinion the horse is sick, lame or exhausted; C: for misuse of the whip or spurs or the ill treatment of the horse; D: for interfering with another competitor; E for any other unseemly behaviour.
23. Keep the parking area clean and tidy and use the blocked area provided for manure.
24. All riders **must** provide a volunteer. Please select your volunteer job through EvoEvents you can do this at the time of entering or later.
25. Stallions may enter but please refer to rules regarding stallion management 21.1
