Riders

All riders must be a financial member of ESNZ (www.nzequestrian.org.nz) or pay a \$16.30 casual day fee which we collect on your behalf and pay in its entirety to ESNZ as at 9pm **Thursday** before start of competition – if you have any problems please contact us.

Horses

Equines do not need to be registered for Show Jumping or Show Hunter classes.

Designation of disciplines:

Show Jumping – these days are non-carded, local events as per Article 250.
Show Hunter – these days are Introductory events as per Rule B.4.

Prizes:

Ribbons 1st – 6th in each class per day (apart from Show Hunter class 23).
Sash for overall Topscore Champion & Reserve in each height presented on the final day (apart from 40cm and 50cm SJ).

How the day works:

Pony's will compete first followed by horses (class order).
The times will be scheduled (draw order).
Combinations limited to a maximum of four (4) rounds in total – 3 max in series (not classes 1, 2 and 23) and one extra warm up class.

Start time determined by entries – between 8am and 9am.

General Rules & Conditions – Please read carefully

1. **ESNZ & EVENT RULES:** Classes run under ESNZ rules, the Board reserves the right to alter and/or cancel the programme or prizes if necessary within ESNZ rules. The Organisers & WECT disclaim any & all liability in the event of accident to rider, horse, spectator, or property. WECT reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. **PONIES:** - Pony riders to be 17yrs and under. Adults may ride ponies, but they will not be scored in either the Show Jumping or Show Hunter classes.
3. **TYPE OF EVENT:** This is an ungraded series, Riders DO have to be registered with ESNZ, as either an introductory or full financial member with ESNZ. Horses DO NOT have to be registered with ESNZ.
4. **AGE OF RIDERS ON HORSES:** As per Show Hunter rule B.6 and Jumping Article 255.5 horses must be ridden by a rider over the age of 12 years (using 1 August date method).
5. **YARDING:** Yards are compulsory and must be used at all times - there is no tying to truck or floats at any time. Yards will be allocated to you. If you intend to arrive Saturday, overnight yarding is available for \$12 per horse. Please ensure you leave your yard tidy, any damage will be charged out. Yards with manure in will be charged out at \$20.00 per yard. ID tags must be worn at all times whilst in yards.
6. **REFUNDS:** Refunds will be given at the discretion of the Board. Requests must be made in writing on our official form within 7 days of the event together with a Vet, Farriers or Doctor's Certificate. Admin and EE fees are non refundable at any time (even if the event is cancelled due to unexpected issues).
7. **DOGS:** MUST be on a lead at ALL times and REMAIN in the carpark. Failure to comply may result in elimination from the event.
8. **LUNGING:** No lunging on the competition side of the boat ramp road. You can lunge in the cross country paddock to the South of the carpark.
9. **ENTRIES:** All entries to www.evovevents.co.nz.
10. **ENTERING** – if you are unsure which class you should enter email admin@horses.net.nz or ring Kara on 027 499 5055
11. **EVENT ATTIRE:** Minimum Standard of dress to be worn: Breeches or Jodhpurs; Jodhpur boots, Gaiters (short leggings /chapettes) or riding boots must be worn. Shirts must have a collar and sleeves (short or long) and be predominantly one colour. (This includes polo shirts) Riding jackets are not compulsory. Yellow tagged helmet compulsory.
12. **COMPETING HORSES:** Competing horses ONLY are allowed at the event – which includes the yards, carpark & surrounding areas. Any non-competing horses brought to site will result in the owner's elimination. This includes minis.
13. **MEDICAL:** If any rider is injured or has a fall as at start of competition (official start time 7.30am) they MUST be checked by our medic before they can continue.
14. **NUMBER OF ROUNDS** - Maximum of four (4) jumping classes per combination (across both Show Jumping and Show Hunter) = 3 in series classes (not class 1, 2 or 23) and 1 warm up round = 4 in total.
15. **STALLIONS** – Riders to advise organisers of stallion's entry, requirements & must comply with the ESNZ article 133 of the General Regulations.
16. **HORSE SHARING** - Horse/Pony only to be ridden by 1 rider per day. There is no sharing of ponies/horses allowed.
17. **PHOTOS** – please note that our official photographer and WECT staff take photos for Facebook and advertising purposes. These may be used by WECT without further reference to competitors unless you specially request not to be included in photos of this type.
18. **NO OTHER RIDERS** – Under no circumstances are any riders or spectators, other than the competing riders allowed to sit and/or ride any horse/pony competing.
19. **HORSE IDENTIFICATION** – All horses/ponys are required to have identification on at all times while yarded (this needs to have the owner's name and a contact phone number). Can be attached to the halter.
20. **BACK NUMBERS** – All riders are required to wear a back number at all times while riding. The numbers are A4 size and are suitable for a number holder (like at horse trials). The number will be pre-printed and must be collected from the office before the horse/pony is mounted and worn at all times. You must bring your own back number holder.
21. **CLASS CHANGES ETC** – See box on page 3 in relation to class changes, alterations, or additions.

Show Jumping Classes – Draw order

Class 1 and 2, 3 and 4, 13 and 14 - CTT = One round closest to the optimum time (not the fastest), no time faults if over.

Classes 5-12 and classes 15-22 - 2-Phase Competition = Article No: 274.1.5.2. Is run in 2 phases. Those clear in the 1st Phase continue into the 2nd Phase without interruption. If a combination has faulted in the 1st Phase, then the judge will ring the bell after the completion of the 1st Phase to indicate to the rider to stop.

Topscores are height based (i.e. if you do class 24 and 25 and place 1st-10th, your points will be added together)
