EVENT RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries via Evo Events.
- Entries close 5pm Friday 19th June 2026.
- Entry fee \$50 per combination for full day or part day.
- Payment via Evo Events by Polipay or by direct credit to:

- Riders will not be able to compete if payment has not been received.
- Classes are judged according to RAS, ESNZ and NZPCA rules.
- Riders must wear yellow tagged, approved safety helmets. Safety vests are optional for jumping classes.
- Riders ride at their own risk.
- Event starts at 9.00am. Show jumping classes start at 12.30pm.
- Classes will run in class order. Gate stewards will announce classes but may not call riders by name. Please be prepared for the classes you have entered.
- Maximum 2 show jumping rounds per combination if competing in the gymkhana. 3 rounds max if show jumping only.
- Refunds issued minus \$10 admin fee & evo fees.
- Plaiting/jackets optional. Tidy appearance is essential.
- This is a public domain. Please pick up and remove all horse manure. The grounds are to be left free of any horse or hay waste.
- LEAD REIN is for those combinations not confident to ride off the lead rein yet.
- FIRST YEAR RIDDEN is for those combinations for which it is their first season off the lead rein and not yet competing in novice events or classes.
- The organising committee reserves the right to combine or alter classes depending on numbers.
