Entries via **Evo Events**. All queries to the Event Secretary: eventingwellington@gmail.com. Enter up to **3 classes at \$70 plus booking fee per combination plus Evo Booking Fee**. The entry fee gets a maximum of **3 rounds at your chosen height, with 1 round able to be used at the next height up on the day if the round goes well for you!** — every completed round earns a chocolate fish. No ESNZ membership required (free Community membership accepted).

ESNZ Training / Practice Day Guidelines — how we comply

ESNZ guideline	How this training day complies
Heights & format	Classes are arena-eventing style with flagged SJ and XC-type fences only. Not a registered event — results are not recorded.
Prizes	A chocolate fish for every completed round.
Medical cover	A Designated First Aid Officer with a first aid kit is on site for the entire day. The local on-call vet will be notified.
Safety & welfare rules	ESNZ Dangerous Riding, Welfare of the Horse and Fall of Horse/Rider rules apply exactly as at a registered event.
Gear	Cross-country standard gear is mandatory in all classes: approved, tagged helmet and a body protector meeting the current minimum standard.
Authority & liability	The Organising Committee has the same rights and authority as at a registered event, and the ESNZ Disclaimer of Liability (Article 610) applies in full — see below.

Refunds, Withdrawals & Substitutions (ESNZ Rules for Eventing, Article 646)

Under Article 611, the Organising Committee sets the withdrawal and refund policy for this event, with Article 646 as the minimum standard for refunds. Our policy applies the Article 646 minimums:

When you withdraw (scratch)	Refund
Before entries close	Entry fees refunded in full.
After entries close, but more than 48 hours before the day (in writing)	Refund of entry fees less 20%. No vet or medical certificate needed for a one-day.
Within 48 hours of the start of the day	No refund, except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

All withdrawals should be notified to the Event Secretary through Evo Events before the day begins. Evo Events transaction fees are non-refundable. If the Organising Committee cancels the day (e.g. weather or ground conditions), riders will be advised of refunds as soon as possible.

Important Notes

- Health & Safety / Disclaimer of Liability:** Article 610 of the ESNZ Rules for Eventing applies — in short, neither the organiser, ESNZ, nor their representatives accept liability for accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, owners, spectators, vehicles or property, however caused.
- By entering, riders acknowledge this is a training day with no medical support beyond the Designated First Aid Officer, agree to jump flagged fences only, and to follow all property and dangerous-riding rules.
- Dogs on leads only. Please take all rubbish, hay and manure home with you.
