Select the Roydvale Financial Member discount to reduce your entry to \$30.
Please note: Roydvale Financial Members are already added to the Roydvale jobs roster.

Late Fee: \$20 once the event or classes have closed.

Entries

Entries close: 20 July 2026 at 12:00am, or earlier if full.

Conditions of Entry

1. **Event Entry Payment**
Payment must be made online at the time of entry. No entries are deemed received unless paid in full.
2. Riders enter the event acknowledging that all three phases may be running within view of each other at the same time. For example, while a rider is completing dressage, other horses may be on the Cross Country or Show Jumping courses or warming up for those phases.
3. All rubbish must be removed from the grounds. This includes manure and any waste from around trucks or floats.

4. Each entry, per horse, must either provide one named helper who can complete the required task, or pay the No Helper Provided Donation fee. Helpers who do not report on the day may result in withdrawal of the associated rider entry, with no ride and no refund, unless remedied before competing on the day. Roydvale Financial Members must select the Roydvale Financial Member option for their entry to be accepted.
5. Overall scores within classes will be provided online (EvoEvents).
6. The committee reserves the right to alter, delete, or combine classes. Entry numbers are limited. Classes may be split based on numbers and, where practical, by age groups.
7. Dressage, Show Jumping, and Cross Country will be run and scored under ESNZ/NZPCA rules. An ordinary snaffle bridle is required for dressage.
8. Gear checks will be carried out under ESNZ rules. Failure to comply may result in elimination. No whips are permitted for dressage, as per ESNZ test rules. Dressage tests may only be called for the 65cm and 80cm classes.
9. Riders must wear correct attire for all phases. Pony Club uniform is welcome and acceptable. Long hair must be tied up, preferably in a hair net.
10. Only horses or ponies entered and competing are allowed on the grounds.
11. Hard hats must be worn in all phases. All helmets must have an NZPCA/ESNZ approved tag attached.
12. Back protectors are compulsory for Cross Country and must meet the minimum standard effective from August 2020:
BETA EN13158 2009/2018 Level 3 or ASTM F1937.
Back protectors may also be worn for all jumping phases. Riders must be wearing the back protector they are competing in for gear check, Cross Country warm-up, and while competing on Cross Country.
13. The NZEF Doping Policy applies to both horses and riders. Please refer to the NZPCA Rule Book.
14. The event will be subject to the Fair Play Charter and Code of Conduct. The NZPCA Yellow Report Form will be in place on the day.
15. **Concussion Rule**
Riders who have had a fall in the last three weeks and suffered concussion are not eligible to start any ODE without a doctor's certificate. The NZPCA Green Card system will also be in place. Riders suspected of receiving a concussion at this event will be issued an NZPCA Green Card.

16. Competitors, helpers, and spectators enter the grounds and ride at their own risk. Roydvale Pony Club accepts no responsibility for any injury, loss, or damage to property, horse, pony, rider, or spectator. Any competitor requiring medical or veterinary attention may receive invoices for that treatment.
17. A vet will be on site for the 105cm Cross Country and on call otherwise. Medical cover will be on site.
18. The event will be held wet or fine. There will be no cancellations.
19. Refunds of 75% of entry fees will be provided with either a veterinary certificate for the horse entered, or a medical certificate for the rider entered, provided it is emailed to Roydvale.Event@gmail.com within seven days of the competition.
20. The schedule will be available online from the Thursday prior to the event. Please print your own copy and bring it with you on the day. The running order will be strictly adhered to. Courses will be open for walking from 10:00am on the Friday prior to the event.
21. Back number holders: please bring your own and print your own numbers as sent.
22. Once your entry has been submitted, all changes must be communicated to the via My Entries on the EvoEvents website

No phone calls or private messages, please, as these are difficult to track.
23. Dogs are allowed but must **always** be on a leash.
