NOTES RE TEST DIFFERENCES:

USDF Test	Similar To ESNZ	Differences
Intro A	0A	None - even meters is spelt the same!
Intro B	0B

Training Test 1	1A	
Training Test 2	1B	
Training Test 3	1C	Mvmt 2 & 8 Wording re loop slightly different though the movement is the same
First Level Test 1	Novice 2A	
First Level Test 2	Novice 2B	
First Level Test 3	Novice 2C	Mvmt 7 & 18 Wording re loop slightly different though the movement is the same; Mvmt 22 trot at C instead of M.
Second Level Test 1	3A	Mvmt 2 & 19 trot must be sitting; Mvmt 3 transitions and trot incl in mark; Mvmt 20 one mark for transitions and trot whereas ESNZ have split into two movements
Second Level Test 2	3B	Mvmt 2/7 collected trot is included with Mvmt 3/8 transitions. Mvmt 4/5 half circle marked with shoulder in instead of separate marks, therefore one less mark but mvmts ride the same; Mvmt 16/23 transitions and canter incl in mark
Second Level Test 3	3C	Mvm 2/7 trot must be sitting. Mvmt 2/7 collected trot is included with Mvmt 3/8 transitions. Mvmt 19/23 collected canter is included with transitions.

NOTES:

Minor wording differences - typically this is that the USDF tests expect you to continue in the same direction at the same gait after an instruction, where ESNZ specify. For example, "between H-C develop working canter, M working trot" as opposed to "between M&C develop working canter, CM working canter, M working trot"

Free walk on a long rein is just free walk for USDF but it does mean long rein as well, specified in directives

Introductory Level coefficients are different. Rider's position and use of aids receive separate marks and there is a mark for geometry and accuracy

Training Level [Preliminary equivalent] coefficients are different. Riders position and use of aids receive separate marks; impulsion has a coefficient of 2 instead of 1

First Level [Novice equivalent] coefficients are different. Riders position and use of aids receive separate marks; impulsion has a coefficient of 2 instead of 1

Second Level [Elementary equivalent] coefficients are different. Riders position and use of aids receive separate marks; impulsion has a coefficient of 2 instead of 1



Rules & Conditions

1. \$12 Ground Fee per horse, \$5 Administration Fee per entry, non refundable Evo fee \$1.75 per class.
2. The Organising Committee has the right to alter or delete classes as it sees fit. All classes open to hacks and ponies.
3. Refunds after closing only on production of doctor's or vet's certificate, less 20% administration costs.
4. Entries/class sizes may be limited. Some classes may be run back to back.
5. Any entries not paid at closing date will be automatically cancelled. You can then apply for a late entry as below.
6. Entries close as stated on programme. Late entries may be accepted, where there is room in the classes, at the secretary's discretion and will incur a **\$10** late entry fee. This will be enforced.
7. Draw times will be emailed, or check www.evoevents.co.nz.
8. Writers needed, please email secretary.
9. The OC accepts no liability for damage, loss or injury to competitors, spectators or their property.
10. The OC has the right to refuse any entry without reason.
11. All dogs on leads or associated rider disqualified.
12. Lunging in designated area only.
13. No access to arenas apart from your designated competition slot.
14. THERE IS NO WATER ON THE GROUNDS SORRY. You will need to bring your own.
15. Manure in roadside treelines only - not boundaries with neighbours.
16. Any horse or rider proving a nuisance to other riders/horses will have to leave the grounds.
17. All stallions to be identified at all times per NZEF rules plus blue ribbon in tail. Horse & rider to be accompanied by a handler at all times. Prior permission must be requested from the secretary.
18. Any rider or associated person who physically or verbally abuses any volunteer will have to leave the grounds immediately.
19. Collect rosettes at conclusion of classes.
