Event Rules

1. **Payment** must be made by close of entries to confirm your entry. No payment, no entry.
2. **No class changes** will be accepted on the day.
3. Only horses or ponies entered/competing are allowed on the grounds
4. **Dressage Tests** may be commanded for up to 80cm
5. No whips for dressage as per ESNZ eventing test rules.
6. **All Horses must have ID tags.** These need to show the horse name and a contact phone number on halter, bridle or saddle at all times.
7. **Withdrawals, substitutions and refunds:**

Notification of withdrawal from our Event must be given to the Event Secretary via evo change request **prior** to the commencement of the event.

If a horse is withdrawn prior to the closing date for entries, the entry fee will be refunded, less the Evo Events fee and the non-refundable admin fee.

If a horse/rider is withdrawn **AFTER** the closing date of entries and 48 hours prior to commencement of the event, the entry fee will be refunded, less the Evo Events fee, non-refundable admin fee and 20% of the entry, upon production of a veterinary or medical certificate.

Any rider/horse withdrawal **WITHIN** 48 hours of event commencement MAY be refunded (less the non-refundable admin fee, Evo Events fee and 20% of the entry) upon production of a veterinary or medical certificate. These will be approved at the discretion committee during our committee meeting following the event.

Horses may be substituted by the owner or owners of the original Horse or his/their authorised

agent up to the closing date for entries provided that the Event Secretary is informed in writing. Athletes may be substituted by the owner of the Horse up to one hour before the first Athlete is scheduled to commence his Dressage Test provided that the Event Secretary is informed.

All refunds will be processed after our committee meeting **following** this event.

8. **Disciplinary action** will be taken if any person purposely jabs a horse/pony in the mouth or for excessive use of the whip and or spurs.
9. NZPCA approved safety helmet & back protectors must be used and tagged as per ESNZ Eventing rules.
10. Back number holders required = **PLEASE PRINT YOUR OWN NUMBERS**
11. Gear check: Compulsory all phases for First Start, 65cm 80cm and cross country for 95cm. 105m competitors may be spot checked.
12. Riders must wear correct attire for all phases. Jackets or Pony club uniforms (long sleeves) are only acceptable for Dressage and Show jumping. Long sleeves or short sleeves can be worn on cross country. **Long hair must be tied up**, preferably **in a hairnet** and **NO long plaited ponytails**. Back numbers need to be clearly visible.
13. **Ambulance and EMT** will be on site throughout the day.
14. **ALL RIDERS RIDE AT THEIR OWN RISK.** Halswell Pony Club and Christchurch A and P Association, accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider or spectator.
15. Dogs allowed but **must** be on a lead.
16. Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule, combine or cancel classes.
17. Committee reserves the right to remove any horse/ pony it considers dangerous.
18. Protests must be submitted to the event secretary within half an hour of the incident and be accompanied by \$30, which will be refunded if protest is upheld.
19. This event is run under ESNZ General Regulations and ESNZ Eventing Rules Effective 1st August 2026 <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/eventing-rules>
20. NZPCA classes do not count as qualifiers/MERs towards ESNZ Events.
21. Riders eliminated on the xc course may not continue. 3 stops at one Jump, or 4 stops over the course is Elimination, **DO NOT CARRY ON. You must walk home.**
22. Take any rubbish, including horse manure and hay, with you when you leave the event.
23. Concussion: any riders who have suffered a concussion in the six weeks prior to this event may not compete.
24. Elimination – a competitor may be eliminated at any stage of the competition by the ground jury for A: Dangerous Riding, B: in their opinion the horse is sick, lame or exhausted, C: for misuse of the whip or spurs or the ill treatment of the horse, D: for interfering with another competitor, E: for any other unseemly behavior.
25. **Vet** will be on call for the day and on site for the 105m class.
26. The event will be run as scheduled, and may be modified, postponed or canceled due to extreme weather.
27. The program will be emailed and also available on the Halswell Pony Club Facebook Page and NZPCA Canterbury Area Pony Club website on the Wednesday prior to the ODE. Please print off a copy, no copies available on the day.
