Terms & Conditions

- This Series will be run at the following shows:
- Nelson: September 19th/20th2026 Marlborough: October 17th/18th 2026 and Marlborough/Nelson Combined Show: February 6th/7th2027 (Waitangi Weekend in Marlborough).
- Eligible combinations are those who reside in the Nelson ESNZ Area & the Marlborough ESNZ Area.
- There will be a rug for the highest points scoring combinations in each of 4 categories: 90cm Pony/1.0m Pony/1.0m Horse/1.10 Horse.
- Points: 10 points for 1st, 9 points 2nd, 8 points 3rd, 7 points 4th, 6 points 5th, 5 points 6th, 4 points 7th, 3 points 8th, 2 points 9th, 1 point 10th. Points are for the combination.
- A bonus point will be added to combinations who compete at all three shows.
- Combinations can compete in both heights in their category-pony or hack.
- Winners of each category will receive a rug courtesy of the absolute legends RICHMOND SADDLERY!!!

Your job reminder will be emailed to you prior to the Show, you must turn up for your job!

ESNZ CONDITIONS

Reading the Show Conditions are part of the conditions for entry. This show will be run under ESNZ rules: www.nzequestrian.org.nz

1. The classes listed as ESNZ Competitions will be conducted under the ESNZ General Regulations and the applicable Discipline Rules. FEI Rules will apply where relevant.
2. By submitting an entry, the Competitor or Person Responsible confirms that they agree to be bound by the ESNZ Constitution, the ESNZ General Regulations, the applicable Discipline Rules and all Event conditions set out on the Schedule, for the purposes of their participation in this ESNZ Competition.
3. ESNZ, Affiliate Groups, Organising Committees and their officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteer and representatives accept no liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness, including to horses, owners, competitors, volunteers or property arising out of or connected with this Event, except to the extent that such liability cannot be lawfully excluded.
4. Any non-ESNZ Competitions held at this Event are run independently of ESNZ, and ESNZ Insurance (for Members) and ESNZ dispute processes do not apply to those competitions.
5. Riders are expected to be familiar with the rules of entry where a qualification is necessary, failure to do this might result in a disqualification after the event. For qualification info for National Series Classes, please refer to Annex 11 of the ESNZ Rulebook: www.equestrian.org.nz

REGISTERING FOR THE SHOW

All competitors must have some form of ESNZ membership or registration. Please check yours is updated BEFORE you enter the Show.- please study the table below to find your fit. If you don't have a membership in place, please tick the Casual Day membership box as you enter on the EvoEvents website – this is most suitable for those combos planning to compete locally and at introductory heights.

Horses are restricted to 1.10m and Under. Ponies are restricted to 1.00m and Under.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES/ PAYMENTS/ CLASS CHANGES/ SCRATCHING

- Entries close: 5pm 16/09/2026. All fees should be paid at time of entry (Poli payment) and will be HELD until paid. All unpaid fees at close of entries will be levied an extra \$10.

- Account for any manual internet payment is: **WESTPAC 03 0693 0168083 00**. Use rider name as reference and please note the suffix number on this account.
- Scratching: This is if you no longer wish to or are unable to compete in the class and are withdrawing. All scratchings should be completed on your EE portal by 5pm the day prior. In late or unexpected situations, your scratching must still be notified to the gate keeper of your ring.
- Class Change: Entry or change into the first class of the day must be made by 5pm the previous day. These should be made on your EvoEvent portal. No emails or personal messages, these can be missed by a busy office. Changed entries must ride first in drawn classes. Previous class will be refunded at 80%.
- Any vet or doctor's medical certificate must be emailed to the secretary within 3 working days of show conclusion for a fees refund to be considered. If a refund is paid will be less fixed administration costs (-20%).
- **Maximum classes per day, per combination:**
- Ring 1: two classes
- Ring 2: three classes
- If competing in Ring 1 & Ring 2: three classes

COMMON FEES:

- **Administration Fee:** \$20.00
- **ESNZ Jumping Levy:** \$9.50 per horse
- **EvoEvents \$1.15 per class:** This is a compulsory fee for your use of the software (NSJ pays a separate fee) and even if you have had to scratch before paying in full it **will stay on your account as a debit amount until paid.**

Other Fees

- **Camping:** \$10 per night per truck/float at Richmond Showgrounds. Showers are available.
- **Covered yard or stable:** \$20 per horse per night. Please advise preference for a covered yard or a stable, we will do our best to accommodate, all allocated on first in/first served basis, with priority given to travelling riders. Once covered yards are allocated, only stables will be available.

YARDING

- All yarded/stabled horses must have their name and contact number of the person responsible clearly visible on a tag attached to the head collar or rug as per JUMPING RULES 200.7.1.
- PLEASE: no sawdust to be put into front part of covered yards at Richmond Park.. Remove hay & manure from yards, stables and float area! Not doing so could result in a name and shame. Please report any damage so we can fix or allocate you a new one.

GENERAL

- **Under no circumstances is there to be any riding on the racetrack and crossing of the tack must only be within the designated area.**
- **All falls during competition or in the warm up ring must be seen by the medical staff on the grounds.**
- Formal turnout is expected for riders competing in Ring 1 and encouraged for Ring 2. Yellow tagged helmets to be used while mounted at all times.
- There will be no back numbers required for this Show. You must ride in DRAW ORDER in both ring 1 & 2.
- The NSJ O/C reserves the right to alter or delete classes, alter prize money or substitute for product in the programme, as they see fit. The organising committee reserves the right to not accept an entry.
- Prize money will be paid by direct credit, within 10 days, please ensure your bank account and other details are up to date on the EvoEvents website: <https://www.evoevents.co.nz>
- Combinations can start in only one of the Horse Championship classes 205 & 206. If the combination has competed in a higher height class at the Show, then they are not eligible for the class.
- Riders must nominate which class is to count for points before the show commences if entering both of the "**SI Pony Championship Series**" classes (201,202) otherwise only points from the higher height will be counted. Points for these series are gained by the pony and must be the same combination for the series.

- Riders gaining first round faults of 12 or more in the **"South Island Pony Mini Prix Championship Series"** class (202) do not gain points.
- Any protest must be lodged with the secretary within half an hour of the finish of the class involved, along with a refundable deposit of \$50 if protest is upheld.
- Riders must comply with ESNZ Health and Safety regulations and any health guidelines applicable at the time. All competitors are competing at their own risk.
- The NSJ Organising Committee is committed to running the safest competition possible and may change or alter the programme or a course due to adverse conditions, if they see fit.
