Gates open at 8am and Office opens at 8:30am. Dressage starts 9am. XC and SJ courses available for walking from 8am

Rules of entry:

1. This competition is run under NZPCA First Start™ An Introduction to Competitive Riding Regulations August 2021 - <https://www.nzpca.org/events/first-start-1>
2. NZPCA approved and tagged safety helmet & back protectors must be worn.
3. Back numbers will be supplied. You may bring your own back number holder if you wish, but you will be responsible for printing your own number.
4. Program will be available on EvoEvents on the Thursday prior to the event. Please print a copy. Copies will not be available on the day.
5. Gear Check is compulsory for all phases.
6. Pony Club uniform is acceptable. Long sleeves are encouraged on XC. Long hair must be tied up, preferably in a hairnet. Back numbers must be clearly visible
7. ALL RIDERS RIDE AT THEIR OWN RISK. North Otago Pony Club accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider, or spectator.
8. No dogs permitted on the grounds. You will be asked to leave.
9. Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule or combine classes.
10. The Committee reserves the right to remove any horse or pony it considers to be dangerous.
11. Riders may have their dressage tests commanded.
12. Riders eliminated on the XC course must not continue and must walk back. Three stops at one jump, or four stops over the course is elimination, do not carry on!
13. It is compulsory to be checked by the First Aid following a fall anywhere on the grounds.
14. Please take any rubbish, including horse manure and hay, with you when you leave the event.
15. Concussion: any rider who has suffered a concussion in the 21 days prior to this event may not compete.
16. Elimination – a competitor may be eliminated at any stage of the competition by the ground jury for:
 - a) Dangerous Riding,
 - b) in their opinion the horse is sick, lame or exhausted,
 - c) for misuse of the whip or spurs or the ill treatment of the horse,
 - d) for interfering with another competitor,
 - e) for any other unseemly behaviour.
17. The event will be held wet or fine. In the unlikely event of a cancellation, for example, due to extreme weather conditions or a natural disaster, all riders will be notified via email and a notification will be posted on NOPC Facebook page.
