All riders must be a financial member of ESNZ (www.nzequestrian.org.nz) or pay a \$16.30 casual day fee which we collect on your behalf and pay in its entirety to ESNZ as at 9pm **Thursday** before start of competition – if you have any problems please contact us.

Horses/Ponys

Equines do not need to be registered or have Discipline Starts for this Dressage series.
There are no separate pony classes.

Designation of discipline:

This is an ungraded four day series run under the Rules of ESNZ Dressage – effective 1 August 2025 (including any updates from the 1st of August 2026).
Levels - Introductory – Grand Prix (DNZ), Working Equitation and Lead Rein.

Prizes:

Rosettes 1st – 6th in each class per day.

Spot prizes per day.

Garland for overall Topscore Champion & Sash for Reserve in each division on the final day.

Other overall awards and trophies noted on the final page of this schedule.

How the days work:

Choose your division and enter the class/tests for each day. The tests get progressively harder throughout the series with a test at a higher level on the final day.

You are allocated points for placings for each class. The points are accumulated towards topscores in each division and some categories (set out on the final page of this schedule).

General Rules & Conditions – Please read carefully

1. **Start time** – Anticipated start time is 9.00am each day. But this may change depending on entry numbers.
2. **Health and Safety** – Competitors and spectators attending this show do so at their own risk, and they must abide by the WECT Health and Safety rules. They can be found on the EE website along with the Disclaimer, also on www.horses.net.nz.
3. **Programme and Class Rules** – All classes are run under ESNZ rules. All riders must be a member of ESNZ. The Committee reserves the right to - alter and/or cancel the programme if necessary within ESNZ rules. Max of 3 tests per combination per day, but only 2 count for the topscore.
4. **Entries online:** www.evoevents.co.nz – Entries are to be paid by Polipay at the time of entry. Any not paid using Poli will be waitlisted and only allowed a start once payment received if there is space. Our bank details are: 03 0314 0183823 01 please put your name down and WINTDR for the reference.
5. **Payments** – Any outstanding fees owed to WECT will need to be paid before you enter any WECT events.
6. **Bridle and Saddle blanket numbers** – Both ESNZ bridle numbers must be used (if your horse has EVER been registered with ESNZ for any discipline). If not you are required to use our saddle blanket numbers – this also applies to warming up, these can be collected from the office – pay with entry - refund given once returned. Both numbers must be attached prior to entering the competition area (failure to do so, may result in elimination). ID tags must be worn at all times (yarding, warming up and competing).
7. **Commanding of Tests** – All Tests may be commanded, except for FEI tests.
8. **Objections** – All objections must be lodged with the event secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a \$50 fee.
9. **Yards/ID Tags** – Day and overnight yards must be booked online at time of entry. Yards are compulsory and will be allocated (day yard – \$12 per horse per day, overnight yard \$12 per horse). Please ensure you leave your yard tidy, any damage will be charged out, yards with manure in will be charged at \$20 per yard. Please ensure that your horse is wearing ID Tags at all times while in the yards (horse name and owner contact phone number). There is no tying to floats/trucks at any time.
10. **Rosettes** – 1st to 6th rosettes in each class. These will be available for collection from the office 30 minutes after final posted score. We will not post rosettes.
11. **Final Day Prizes** – Topscore Classes: Champion in each class section will receive a garland made by Sue McKenna, Reserve will receive a sash. Topscore Categories: Champion and Reserve will receive sashes. Topscore accumulating results for each class will be available on www.horses.net.nz after each show day. Topscore presentations will be held on the last day, you must be present to receive your prize.
12. **Scratchings** – Must be notified by phone (before 9pm) prior to the event. During the event, at the office or phone 027 499 5055. Refunds will be given at the discretion of Organising Committee, requests must be in writing on our official form (available from www.horses.net.nz), and within 7 days of event with a Vet., Doctors or farriers cert.
13. **Dogs** – MUST be on a lead at ALL times and REMAIN in the carpark. Failure to comply will result in elimination from the event.
14. **Horses** – All horses on the grounds must be competing, no companion horses allowed (including minis).
15. **Test Sheets** – Envelopes are available from the office for tests to be sent out (cost \$3.00)
16. **Newcomer section** – Riders may stay in this section for the duration of the series even if they received 1st to 6th on any of the days. If a combination is also competing in the Fiber Fresh WECT Winter Show Jumping/Hunter series, they cannot enter Newcomer. Combinations who have placed 1st-4th overall in previous years are not eligible for this section again.
17. **Medical** – If any rider is injured or has a fall as at the start of competition (official start time 7.30am) they MUST be checked by our medic before they are allowed to remount. Failure to comply may result in elimination from the event.
18. **Competing riders and horses/ponies** – Under no circumstances are any riders or spectators, other than the competing riders allowed to sit and/or ride any horse/pony competing. Only horses competing are allowed on the show grounds.
19. **Stallions** – Riders are to advise organisers of stallion's entry, requirements and must comply with the ESNZ article 133 of the General Regulations and Article 147 of the Dressage Rules.
20. **Refunds due to unforeseen circumstances** – Admin and EE fees are non-refundable at any time (even if the event is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances).
21. **Overall points** – points are calculated on each combination.
22. **Classes entered** – it is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have entered the correct class, but please ask if you are unsure.
23. **Refuse entries** – WECT reserves the right to refuse any entry.
24. **Photos** – please note that our official photographer and WECT staff take photos for Facebook and advertising purposes. These may be used by WECT without further reference to competitors unless you specially request not to be included in photos of this type.
