



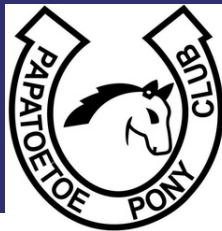

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Health and Safety Policy can be located in the pavilion. All competitors must familiarise themselves with the health and safety policy in this schedule and by entering the show, you accept our Health and Safety conditions.

- Abuse of stewards, officials, volunteers, etc trainers and fellow competitors will not be tolerated.
- Parents are responsible for children under the age of 16 at all times.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries will only be accepted with full payment at the time of finalising entry on Evo Events.
- All riders compete at their own risk..
- All classes run under current ESNZ/NZPCA rules.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the programme
- Casual tidy riding attire.
- Scratchings received after closing will need a vet certificate and will be up to the OC
- Classes 8,9,10 horses and ponies will all run in the same class, clear rounds get a ribbon .

- Entries may be limited in some classes and places will be offered on a first paid basis. Those not accepted into a class will be eligible for a full refund of entry fees for that class.
- Class 7 prize money total EF paid on 1:7 ratio
- All riders must have the correctly tagged helmet (yellow) as per ESNZ Rules..
- Place getters will be announced at the end of each class and posted to Evo.
- Series points awarded for overall prizes (classes 7,8,9,10 don't count). Overall winner for the Hack and Pony rings will be presented with a rug sponsored by Kingsway Automotive & Electrical.

LATE ENTRIES: \$20 late fee for equines not entered in the show and \$3 per class change. Entries close Tuesday week before each show.

ALL changes to be made through EVOEVENTS Over all SERIES WINNERS will be awarded a Rug and a Prestige Equestrian Voucher. Points awarded from classes 1-5 and classes 12-15.

SCRATCHINGS:

Refunds:

Scratchings done before closing date 5pm of each show have all non fixed fees refunded.

- Entry free refunded if notified before 8am Thursday before the show date with doctor/vet certificate.
- Full yarding/camping fee included if notified by 8am Thursday before the show.

All other refunds at OC discretion.

Accounts not paid prior to close of entry will still be charged if scratched/ or a no show without paying. Online entry fee is non-refundable irrespective of when scratching.

REFUNDS: Refunds will be paid electronically following the completion of the show, to the bank account nominated in your Equestrian Entries account.

PRIZE MONEY: All prizemoney and refunds will be paid out electronically, to your bank account and the person who made the entry. Bank accounts must be verified online with Evo Events. Prize money only paid on classes with 10 or more entries or at OC discretion.

DOGS: are welcome at PPC but must be on a leash at all times – failure to comply could result in rider being eliminated.

GATES: Front gates will be unlocked from 7am to 5pm Saturday & Sunday only.

1. No liability: Neither Papatoetoe Pony Club (PPC), Papatoetoe Adult Riding Club (PARC), any committee member of PPC or PARC, any organiser or sponsor of any event hosted by PPC or PARC, nor any service provider or volunteer at any event hosted by PPC or PARC (each a PPC Party) on the grounds at 2 Sutton Road, Brookby, Auckland, including the facilities made available at that address (the PPC Grounds), is liable:
