The XC Course will be available for walking from 3.00pm Saturday 5th September

Camping available at racecourse - \$10 for the night. Open yards and stables \$10 day (only available to those who have booked them on Evo Events). Open yards are limited so please accept they will be issued in order of entry received and full payment made.

To run an ODE event, we require ALL riders to provide a helper. We need fence judges!!

Rules of entry:

1. Back numbers will NOT be provided. Please print and bring your own back numbers and holders.
2. No late entries.
3. Class changes will NOT be accepted on the day.
4. Withdrawals, substitutions and refunds as per Article 646 of ESNZ Rules for Eventing. An admin fee of \$10 per rider applies, this and the Evo and poli fees are non-refundable. Requests for a refund must be made in writing within 7 days of the event.
5. Program will be available on Evo Events on the Thursday prior to the ODE. Please print your own copy, no copies available on the day.
6. Gear check is compulsory for all phases of 65cm & 80cm. Compulsory for XC phase of 95cm with random dressage & SJ gear checks.
7. Riders must wear correct attire for all phases. Pony club uniform is acceptable. show jumping jackets are required. Long hair must be tied up, preferably in a hairnet. Back numbers must be clearly visible.
8. ALL RIDERS RIDE AT THEIR OWN RISK. North Otago Pony Club and the Oamaru Racing Club accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider, or spectator.
9. All Horses must have an ID tag (showing horse name and contact phone number) on at all times.
10. No Dogs.
11. Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule or combine classes.
12. Committee reserves the right to remove any horse or pony it considers to be dangerous.
13. Protests must be submitted to the event secretary within half an hour of the incident and be accompanied by \$50 cash, which will be refunded if your protest is upheld by the TD.
14. Only riders in class 3 (80cm) and class 4 (65cm) may have their tests commanded.
15. Whips are not permitted in dressage phase, but spurs may be worn.
16. Riders eliminated on the XC course must not continue and must walk back. Three stops at one jump, or four stops over the course is elimination, do not carry on!
17. It is the compulsory to be checked by a medic following a fall anywhere on the grounds. This is the rider's responsibility
18. Please take any rubbish, including horse manure and hay, with you when you leave the event.
19. This event is run under ESNZ General Regulations and ESNZ Eventing Rules-Effective 1 August 2024 - <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/eventing-rules/>
20. Concussion: any rider who has sustained a concussion in the 21 days prior to this event may not compete.
21. Elimination – a competitor may be eliminated at any stage of the competition by the ground jury for:
 - a. Dangerous Riding,
 - b. The horse is deemed to be sick, lame or exhausted,
 - c. Misuse of the whip or spurs or the ill treatment of the horse,
 - d. For interfering with another competitor,
 - e. For any other unseemly behaviour.
22. The event will be held wet or fine. In the unlikely event of a cancellation, for example, due to extreme weather conditions or a natural disaster, all riders will be notified via email and a notification will be posted on NOPC Facebook page. In the event of cancellation \$80 of your entry fee will be refunded.
23. Ambulance services will be on site for Cross Country.
24. A vet will be on call for the day.
25. ALL RIDERS MUST PROVIDE ASSISTANCE - THIS IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY.
26. NO HORSES ON THE RACE TRACK.
