Responsibility: It is the rider, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule. By submitting an entry, the Competitor or Person Responsible confirms that they agree to be bound by the ESNZ Constitution, the ESNZ General Regulations, Dressage NZ Rules and all Event conditions set out in the Schedule, for the purposes of their participation in this ESNZ Competition.

Important Information

1. **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without full ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to the 20th September 2026.
2. **All riders** must be members of Gisborne Dressage Group Inc to compete. Annual membership is payable by 30 October - Senior \$45 and Junior \$25 (see subscription notice on website). Day membership is available at \$10 per rider and must be paid on entry.
3. **Preliminary:** Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory Child or Full Competitive membership.
4. **Novice and Above:** Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
5. **Horse and Ponies:** Must have ESNZ Horse/Pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use flexi start at \$5 per test (payable with entries).
6. **ESNZ Registration for Non Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to 20th September 2026 or pay a \$18.00 per day Casual membership. Horses and Ponies may be registered (with no more than 15 Elementary points, or not be registered. Combinations outside the above criteria may compete Hors Concours (H/C). Walk/Trot tests CN riders only (CN to have no ESNZ grading points). Walk/Trot/Canter tests CN-C3 riders (Riders to have no more than 15 points at any level above elementary).
Junior Riders: 16 Years and under as at 1st August 2026. **Senior Riders:** 17 Years and over as at 1st August 2026
7. **Grading Points:** No ESNZ grading points will be awarded for Non-Graded classes or to unregistered horses.
8. **Rules:** This competition will be run under the current (2021) ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
9. **Protests:** Must be lodged within 60 minutes of the official finish time in writing including a fee of \$50.00.
Dressage Top Ten Leagues: Riders wishing to accrue points in any Dressage NZ Top 10 League must have registered online at www.evoevents.co.nz prior to 1st December 2026 for the 2026/27 Season. 10. **Dressage National Leagues & Series:** No points will be accrued for the Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize or AMS Pony, Young rider and U25 Performance Award at Local Events.
11. **Dressage Tests:** All tests are from DNZ Test book version 2023 or FEI Website.

Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
3. Maximum of 2 Tests per Horse/Pony.

4. **Helmets:** ESNZ approved tagged riding helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
5. **Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event. If you want to bring a non-competing horse/pony they must be entered in a class and the rider must have either a full, introductory or casual day ESNZ membership.
6. **Liability:**
 - a. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b. ESNZ, Gisborne Dressage Group, Organising Committees and their officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteers and representatives, Gisborne Showgrounds, Dressage NZ accepts no liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness, including to horses, owners, spectators, vehicles or any personal property, arising out of or connected with this Event, except to the extent that such liability cannot be lawfully excluded.
 - c. Gisborne Showgrounds, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Gisborne Dressage group shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such, brought in/stored at the venue, during the event.
7. **Health & Safety:**
 - a) ESNZ, Gisborne Dressage Group, Organising Committees and their officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteers and representatives are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
 - b) Competitor or Exhibitor must comply with the appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
 - c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
 - d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ, Dressage NZ Rules, the Gisborne Dressage group and Gisborne Showgrounds Health & Safety Policy's
 - e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
 - f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
 - g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
 - h) Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.
8. **ESNZ Concussion Policy:**
 - a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines. [Link to ESNZ Concussion Policy](#)
 - b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
 - c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or leaving the grounds.
9. **ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy**

Entry Conditions

1. Entries Close **Thursday 10th September 2026**
2. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz
3. Late penalty fee: Late entries incur a \$10 penalty and will be put on a waiting list for a scratching (if any).
4. Direct credit must be made by close of entry for entry to be accepted.
5. Direct Credit account number **Gisborne Dressage Group, BNZ Gisborne – 02-0636-0335228-000** with name & rider ESNZ Registration number as reference.
6. Draw will be available at www.evoevents.co.nz
7. Classes count for all local leaderboard challenges (Gisborne Dressage members only).
8. For classes 64, 65, 400 and 401, please state the level you are competing at.
9. Non graded classes 50-55 for riders aged 16 or under as at 1-8-26 on a horse or a pony.
10. Non graded classes 56-59 for riders aged 17 or over as at 1-8-26 on a horse or a pony.
11. CN Riders (Newcomer Riders who have never earned grading points at any level at any time in their

life)

12. CN-C3 Riders (Riders who have never earned grading points at any level above Elementary)
13. Withdrawals and Refunds – competitors will be eligible to receive a refund of their entry fee, less the ground/admin levy, with receipt of a vet/farrier/doctors certificate. This is to be received within seven days after the event. All scratching must be notified to Kyla Newton gisbornedressage@gmail.com or 021 1680303.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate or Steward.
3. Any person leading a horse in an arena familiarisation, must be wearing a correctly fitting yellow tagged helmet. All horses being lead must be wearing a bridle with a permitted bit, and with two bridle numbers. A newmarket lead may replace the reins for this purpose.

Horse Identification, Venue, Vehicles, Camping Conditions

Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing.

1. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags also that include person responsible name and mobile phone contact number.
2. All horses/ponies competing in the non graded section must wear identification numbers on both sides of the bridle - available from secretary.
3. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
4. No smoking or vaping in any buildings or stable areas.
5. No Dogs allowed on the grounds (A&P Rules).
6. **If you intend on camping (\$15 per truck/float) or overnight yarding please contact Kim Moss 0272926370 to book.**
