



GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ESNZ and DNZ Waiver

- The classes listed as ESNZ Competitions will be conducted under the ESNZ General Regulations and the applicable Discipline Rules. FEI Rules will apply where relevant.
- By submitting an entry, the Competitor or Person Responsible confirms that they agree to be bound by the ESNZ Constitution, the ESNZ General Regulations, the applicable Discipline Rules and all Event conditions set out in the Schedule, for the purposes of their participation in this ESNZ Competition.
- ESNZ, Affiliate Groups, Organising Committees and their officers, officials, agents, employees, volunteers and representatives accept no liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness, including to horses, owners, competitors, spectators, volunteers or property, arising out of or connected with this Event, except to the extent that such liability cannot be lawfully excluded.

BOIDG Inc runs tournaments under the Constitutional Rules and Regulations of ESNZ and all applicable regulations and rules will be strictly enforced. The Committee reserves the right to alter the programme without notice.

ESNZ Membership

If rider is not a current full financial member of ESNZ or has not paid an ESNZ Introductory membership (\$60.00) please tick the box on EvoEvents when entering to pay a casual day rider membership of \$18.00. The casual day rider membership fee for riders who are not ESNZ members is compulsory and covers the insurance for the day.

Unregistered riders must supply their own horse number. This number will be allocated and recorded on the draw sent to you and in EvoEvents. Numbers should be a minimum size of 9 x 6cm and no more than 10 x 7cm with numbers no smaller than 4.5cm and worn on both sides of bridle or saddle blanket.

All Horses – registered or not – must wear an ID tag on their halter at all times on the grounds when not being ridden, with name of horse, person responsible and contact number clearly displayed. When you ride your registration number is sufficient.

Refund Policy

80% of class entry fees + 100% ground and camping fees; admin & booking fees are non-refundable; only on receipt of doctors or veterinary certificate within 14 days of event. Other refunds may be considered at the discretion of the committee.

Number of classes horse and rider combinations can enter per competition day

Horse and Rider combinations in Levels 0 – 4 may enter a total of 3 classes per day.

Horse and Rider combinations in Levels 5 – 6 may enter a total of 2 classes per day.

Horse and Rider combinations in Level 7 – 9 may enter 1 class per day.

Only horses entered in the competition are allowed on the grounds on the day of our event.
