**\$16** per class

**\$10** per horse ground/admin fee [of which \$6 is non-refundable]

**\$18** per rider admin fee

**\$7** credit off total fees for WRC members (one only)

**\$1.75** per class Evo Events non-refundable admin charge

Volunteers needed to assist with arena setup prior to the day, dressage writers, collecting sheets and arena packdown. Please contact the secretary.

It is the rider, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

1. This event is run as per ESNZ rules and is for registered competitors. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure registrations are current and entries are made in the correct grade.
2. HORS CONCOURS: Any class may be entered HC if the normal entry conditions are not met (may be ridden but scores do not count for places). Normal competition rules must still be adhered to. Tick the HC box online to request. The committee reserves the right to accept or refuse a request for HC.
3. A tagged safety helmet must be worn at all times when the rider is mounted.
4. Adults may ride ponies but must enter the horse class at the level they wish to compete.
5. Protests & Complaints: Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event following Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. The Ground Jury is the sole judge of time in both cases. For complete rules and official documentation required, please refer to <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/> a \$50 fee must accompany any protests and must be in writing.
6. All tests are from DNZ Test book version 2023 Reprint 1 and, for FEI tests, FEI website. Please note that Version 2023 FEI tests for Small, Medium and Big Tour, Prix Caprilli and BG tests will be provided by request.
7. Musical TOC may be split into separate classes if sufficient entries.

#### Event Conditions

1. Amendments: The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. Maximum entries 6 tests per rider per day, and 3 tests per horse/pony per day.
3. Companion Horses: All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be registered at the event, and ground fee of \$12 paid. May only be ridden after finish of last class.
4. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a yard at all times, when not ridden. Prior permission from the secretary must be gained.
5. Liability:
  - a. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
  - b. The organising committee does not accept any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
6. Health & Safety:
  - a. WRC Dressage is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
  - b. Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
  - c. All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the Waimakariri Riding Club's Health & Safety Policy
  - d. Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
  - e. Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
  - f. Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
  - g. Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.
7. ESNZ Concussion Policy:
  - a. This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
  - b. Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
  - c. Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing
8. **Sponsors & Volunteers** We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (sponsors contact details will be listed on the event programme) or in person during the show. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the event office or event manager. Without the generous support we receive from these individuals and businesses, the cost to competitors would be considerably more..

#### Entry Conditions

1. Entries close 9.00pm on the closing date.
2. Refunds with doctors or vet certificate only, less the \$6 non-refundable portion of the admin fee and the Evo class fee..
3. Enter online at [www.EvoEvents.co.nz](http://www.EvoEvents.co.nz)
4. Late entries may be accepted with an additional \$10 fee per class and if space permits.
5. Payment must be made by closing date for entry to be accepted. Combinations will only be entered in the competition draw once full payment has been received. Any entries made without payment by close of entries will be treated as Late Entry and \$10.00 per class penalty will apply, and only accepted where space permits and at the organiser's discretion.
6. Entry fees to be paid to 02-0876-0313132-003, please include rider name and horse as reference.
7. Draw will be available at [www.EvoEvents.co.nz](http://www.EvoEvents.co.nz)
8. Scratchings: Please scratch on Evo Events under 'My Entries' or email event secretary as early as possible. Scratchings on event day text the phone number on the programme.
9. Musical Freestyle classes will be weather dependent due to electrics/speakers.
10. If insufficient entries in Junior classes these classes may be merged with the senior riders.
11. \$7 discount (one only) from total fees for paid up WRC members.

#### Series points:

Points are attributed to combination not the horse.

Must compete a minimum of 2 days to be eligible. Note the MFS is only on Day 1 and Day 3

Points allocated as follows: >72% 10; 70-71.99% 7; 68-69.99% 5; 66-67.99% 4; 64-65.99% 3; 60-63.99% 2; 57-59.99% 1
