PLEASE NOTE: REGISTRATION AND PRIZE MONEY/REFUND PROCEDURE.

Please read these conditions carefully.

You must read all the Land Rover Horse of the Year Regulations & Conditions of entry and abide by them.

It is the responsibility of the Rider/Handler/Person Responsible to know the rules of the class in which they are competing.

Conditions for Standardbred Section:

- Entries close 1/2/2019
- Only Standardbreds with an official harness racing freeze brands are eligible to enter
- Owner must be a current financial member of the NISA, NZSRA or NZSBA at close of entries
- Breastplate number holders are **compulsory** and the competitor is responsible for making the number. Only large black numbers on a white background are acceptable. No other colour combinations or formats are acceptable
- **Height Certificates** - Royal Agriculture Society of NZ (RAS) current Annual or Life Height Certificates or Horse Identification (ID) forms (RAS Certificate). RAS Certificates must be carried at all times by the rider for classes 909 and 910 and be presented upon request.
- **Qualification** - All horses (excluding foals) **MUST** have won (1) Champion Standardbred or (2) Reserve Champion Standardbred or (2) wins in a qualifying class **between 5th March 2018 & 3rd March 2019** in the Standardbred ring at a qualifying show (excludes Land Rover Horse of the Year 2018)
- You must have won (1) Champion Inhand or (2) Reserve Champions Inhand or (2) wins in an Inhand qualifying class at a qualifying show to enter the Inhand section. Qualifying classes for Inhand include Youngstock, Mare/Filly or Colt/Gelding/Stallion classes (i.e. conformation classes)
- You must have won (1) OPEN Champion Ridden or (2) OPEN Reserve Champions Ridden or (2) OPEN wins in a ridden qualifying class at a qualifying show to enter the ridden section. Qualifying classes for ridden include Open or Ladies or Gentleman's Standardbred (Novice wins or Novice Champions do not count for qualification).
- **Attendance** - All horses (excluding foals) **MUST** have competed at a minimum of (3) RAS qualifying shows (excluding Land Rover Horse of the Year 2018) in a Standardbred section **between 5th March 2018 & 3rd March 2019**



STANDARD BRED SCHEDULE 2019

- **Qualifying & Attendance Shows** are ALL RAS affiliated shows, Canterbury Horse & Pony Breeders Show, North Island Standardbred Assn North Island Championship & Pleasure Horse Show (only Inhand & Ridden Championship ring to qualify), NZSRA Championship show (only Open rings to qualify) or South Island Premier Championship Show
- Novice – Is a horse that has **not** won 6 or more 1st in a Standardbred Ridden conformation class at a Qualifying show (Novice, Open, Ladies or Gentleman's) **by 3rd March 2019**. Novice horses are eligible to enter if they have qualified. **Performance cards** must be carried
