Level 2—Protocols—COVID –19

Here is an update on what this means for Woodhill Sands and how we will be operating under Level 2:

- Entries, class changes, scratching MUST be made on-line via Equestrian Entries.
- Payment must be made **in advance of the show** via Internet Banking (please put your name, SJ)

Our bank account is The Woodhill Sands Trust 12-3019-0013702-00 **ENTRIES NOT ACCEPTED UNTIL PAYMENT IS MADE.**

- Please park in the carpark with at least 5 meters between the next float or truck and do not place your horse in a yard next to any other horses. While riding you must practice physical distancing and not share or use anyone else's equipment. We will have restricted numbers of riders.
- You and everyone with you must sign in and out at the gate with appropriate information to make tracing you if necessary possible. To speed this process up please make a note of anyone travelling to the show with you and appropriate contact details for them (email and phone number) with your entry. There is a place to do this under 'volunteers' on your entry form.
- The toilets will be open (but the showers will be closed – open days) and there is a regular cleaning schedule in place. Hand soap and sanitizer is also available at multiple points around the venue.
- Riders and support people need to use gloves or sanitizer located by ring for picking up show jumping poles in the ring and at warm up fences. To be used before entry to the ring and upon exit.
- Please stay at home if you are feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of cold and flu.
- All classes will run in strict draw order - no congregating at gate.
- Café will be open with 2m distancing in place and txt alerts for order pick ups.

Our team will be here to help you during this time as we all navigate the next stage of managing COVID19. I know we are all looking forward to getting back into things so please help us to do this responsibly and safely. The team @ Woodhill Sands





WOODHILL SANDS Practice XC & SJ

Saturday 20th June 2020

These fun training days are a great chance to get your horse jumping cross country and show jumps, There is usually one fully set Show Jumping course that you can adjust heights according to your experience level and practice rounds or a few jumps, plus a variety of cross country fences, which may include banks, ditches, corners, mobiles, skinnies etc.

Room may be limited depending on weather, however with almost 3 acres of sand arenas we are guaranteed to run.

Riders are required to wear back protectors and medical armbands and provide emergency contacts if riding alone.

We strongly recommend having a friend, instructor or family member with you when you jump, however we will have a staff member on hand at all times when you are jumping.

Fences open for jumping will be flagged. Just like in a normal competition situation we ask that you keep the red flag on your right hand side when jumping any fences, this will keep the track around the jumps flowing and avoid head on collisions. We ask that all riders show courtesy to others riding in the same practise session (we try to limit the sessions to four riders per half hour) to give everyone space.

Bookings are essential so we don't have twenty riders all show up at the same time a draw will be posted on the website, usually the day prior to the practice day.

All riders on the day must sign in at the Kiosk and yes it will be serving cold drinks,

- **espresso coffee and light snacks.**

Cost is \$30 per horse including Ground Fee & Admin fee

Course closes at 3pm

Please make sure you book your preferred time to ride and let us know what level you wish to jump. WE HAVE LIMITED SPOTS AVAILABLE FIRST IN IS FIRST SERVED.

9am - 11am 60—80cm

11.30 - 1.30 - 80 - 1.00m

1.30 - 2.30 - Riders may adjust jumps to suit.

Rider's wanting to jump x bars—60cm any time is fine.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

DRESS CODE: -Plaiting & Jackets Optional. All riders must wear medical armbands for all jumping phases, Back protectors are compulsory for any cross country jumping.

DRESSAGE PHASE: - Draw for Dressage will be available on Website Friday 3pm prior to the event. Callers allowed for the Dressage Test. All tests are available from the Woodhill Sands Website's Eventing page.

CROSS COUNTRY/SJ PHASE: -No set time limit for Cross Country. All Classes will run in blackboard order, Each class will be given a set time to jump. * Pre Intro course will be a blend of show jumps and natural fences - x bar jumps, logs etc. and will amount to approx. 10 fences in total. Other Mini ODE levels will have a SJ course of approx. 10 efforts and between 9—13 efforts cross country. No Jumping phase is timed.

Please do not attend this event if you are feeling unwell or showing any signs or flu or colds! You must scratch prior to your start time to qualify for refund.
