- Horses & Ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership.
- All classes run under current ESNZ rules. Series classes run under current series conditions.
- Formal attire in all competition rings.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash.

- STYLE CLASSES One round judged by 2 judges on horse style, (judged following German Young Horse class criteria). Simple brushing boots only.
- For SUPER SERIES conditions see www.woodhillsands.co.nz
- Only one Championship class per horse/pony may be ridden on Sunday, excluding Series Classes.

- CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Online entries close Thursday, 5 November 2020, postal entries close Friday, 29 October 2020 thereafter LATE.
The organisers reserve the right to close entries early if entry numbers are large.
- Postal entries must be on ESNZ official entry forms and posted to
Showjumping Auckland, C/- Gaylene Bullock, 934 Churchill East Rd, RD2, Te Kauwhata 3782.
- LATE ENTRIES: Incur 50% surcharge on class entry. Will start first in the class where class is drawn according to ESNZ rules.
- PAYMENT: **Payment is with entry by POLI pay or credit card on Equestrian Entries at the time of finalising entry.**
Please direct any questions to the Show Secretary. Direct credit payments for non-finalised entries must be received before entry is accepted. **Payment must be made before entry is accepted.**
- SCRATCHINGS: Less 25% if notified before 5pm on Thursday, 12 November. No refunds for scratching or unused yards without a vet or medical certificate after this time.
- PRIZEMONEY: All entry fees and prizemoney are GST inclusive. A GST receipt can be requested after the show provided that the riders' GST number is supplied with entry form. A GST Invoice for entries and prizemoney won is given in return.
All prizemoney and refunds will be paid out electronically, to your bank account.
Bank accounts must be verified online with Equestrian Entries.

LEVIES & FEES

- All riders must be full members of ESNZ.
- ESNZ JUMPING LEVY: \$5 per equine for the show (compulsory).
- ESNZ CASUAL JUMPING LEVY: \$20 per equine per show.
Required for horses not currently registered with ESNZ for Jumping/ Show Hunter. May not compete in any series class or at heights above 1.10m for horses and 1.00m for ponies. NOTE: the rider must be a full member of ESNZ.
- GROUND FEE \$20 per horse/pony.
- YARDING:
Open yards - \$30 per horse for the show.
Yards will be allocated on entry basis – 1st wooden yards, 2nd pipe yards 3rd yards up the hill.
Covered yards/Stable block - \$50 per horse for the show. Grand Prix riders and riders from far away given precedence.
There are no portable Covered Stables this year.
- CAMPING: \$20 per vehicle for the show.

OTHER

- There will be food available on the grounds.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money. Riders will be advised about any changes via email so please ensure your contact details are up to date
- All competitors must familiarise themselves with the health and safety policy in this schedule and sign the H & S event waiver on entry.
- Hay \$15 per bale. Must be preordered, and will be delivered Thursday and Friday. There will be no hay available on site for purchase.
- Shavings, available at no charge from pile.
