General Rules & Conditions – Please read carefully

1. **ESNZ & EVENT RULES:** Classes run under ESNZ rules, the Committee reserves the right to alter and/or cancel the programme or prizes if necessary within ESNZ rules. The Organisers & WEC disclaim any & all liability in the event of accident to rider, horse, spectator, or property
2. **PONIES:** - Pony riders to be 17yrs and under. Adults may ride ponies H/C in the pony class or competitively in the Horse classes.
3. **TYPE OF EVENT:** This is an ungraded series, Riders DO have to be registered with “Equestrian Sport NZ”, as either an introductory or full financial member with ESNZ. Horse DO NOT have to be registered with ESNZ.
4. **YARDS:** Day & overnight yards must be booked online at time of entry. Yards are compulsory and must be used at all times other than saddling up or unsaddling, they will be allocated to you (day yard – \$5.00 per horse per day, overnight yard \$10.00 per horse). Please ensure you leave your yard tidy, any damage will be charged out, yards with manure in will be charged out at \$20.00 per yard. ID tags must be worn at all times whilst in yards.
5. **REFUNDS:** Refunds will be given at the discretion of the Organising Committee, requests must be made in writing on our official form within 7 days of the event together with a Vet, Farriers or Doctor’s Certificate.
6. **DOGS:** must be kept on a lead at all times and must be kept away from the office area.
7. **LUNGING:** No lunging on the sand or polo field
8. **ENTRIES:** All entries to www.equestrianentries.co.nz.
9. **ENTERING** – if you are unsure which class you should enter email admin@horses.net.nz or ring Kara on 0274834328
10. **EVENT ATTIRE:** Minimum Standard of dress to be worn: Breeches or Jodhpurs; Jodhpur boots, Gaiters (short leggings /chapettes) or riding boots must be worn. Shirts must have a collar and sleeves (short or long) and be predominantly one colour. (This includes polo shirts) Riding jackets are not compulsory.
11. **COMPETING HORSES:** Competing horses ONLY are allowed at the event – which includes the yards, carpark & surrounding areas.
12. **MEDICAL:** If any rider is injured or has a fall as at start of competition (official start time 7.30am) they MUST be checked out by our medic before they can continue.
13. Maximum of four (4) jumping classes per horse/pony (across both Show Jumping and Show Hunter) = 4 in total.
14. **Stallions** – Riders to advise organisers of stallion’s entry, requirements & must comply with the ESNZ article 133 of the General Regulations.

COVID-19 RULES & REGULATIONS:

- a. Thank you for your understanding with these new requirements. If we work together, we will ensure that the correct requirements are undertaken.
- b. Entries, class changes and scratchings MUST be made on-line via Equestrian Entries. No on the day entries will be accepted. Class changes/additions MAY be accepted on the day if numbers permit.
- c. Physical distancing: we recommend that you stay at least 1m from anyone not in your bubble. This includes in all competition areas, warm up areas, carpark, washbay, yards and around the secretary’s office.
- d. Hygiene: there are several hand sanitiser stations on site (coloured bright yellow). Please use them regularly. You are also able to wash your hands at the washbay or toilet area frequently. The toilets will be cleaned throughout the day.
- e. Riders and support people need to use gloves (riding gloves are fine) for picking up poles in the ring and at warm up fences.
- f. Unwell: if you are unwell or have any flu-like symptoms, please do not come onto site.
- g. All classes will run in draw order – no congregating at the gate.

SCORING POINTS FOR TOPSCORES: 1st = 20, 2nd = 18, 3rd = 16, 4th = 14, 5th = 12, 6th = 10, 7th = 8, 8th = 6, 9th = 4, 10th = 2

Under no circumstances are any riders or spectators, other than the competing riders allowed to sit and/or ride any horse/pony competing.

Show Jumping Classes – 60cm, 70cm 80cm – One round closest to judge’s mystery time (not fastest time). 90cm & above 2 phase – Draw order

(2-Phase Competition - Article No: 274.5.2. Is run in 2 phases. The 1st Phase consisting of 7-9 obstacles, and the 2nd Phase 4-6. Those clear in the 1st Phase continue into the 2nd Phase without interruption. If a combination has faulted in the 1st Phase, then the judge will ring the bell after the completion of the 1st Phase to indicate to the rider to stop).
