### **Terms and Conditions**

#### **Covid-19 Conditions**

- 1. This is a vaccine pass only show and is closed to spectators. Competitors should advise their friends and family of this, please.
- 2. Competitors must provide all requested Covid information in order for their entries to be accepted.
- 3. You must be physically well to attend our event. If you are unwell, are waiting test results, are under "close contact" restrictions, or displaying any Covid-19 symptoms you must stay home and must not attend the show.
- 4. Any persons at the show who receive notification of "close contact" status during our event must advise us, and immediately leave the grounds.
- 5. You must comply with all Government requirements relevant to the alert level during the show.
- 6. Please comply with any requests from the organising committee. Running shows under Covid-19 is complicated, expensive and exhausting. Your understanding and respect is appreciated.
- 7. You must stay in your allocated zone at all times (when not on your horse) and wear your wrist band at all times. You must only use the bathroom facilities in your allocated zone.
- 8. If you leave your zone, you must maintain at least 2m physical distance from other people and wear a mask at all times.
- 9. Failure to comply with Covid-19 regulations may result in your elimination and removal from the grounds.

### **Entry Conditions**

Online entries close Thursday 17 February 2022. *No postal* or email entries will be accepted. Entries are only accepted once we have received all required documentation (eg Covid info) and they are paid in full. Late entries will not be accepted. *Entries may be capped and closed early if we reach capacity*.

#### **Definitions**

Late Entry Deemed to be a new competitor or horse *not already entered* by the closing date. Late

entries will not be accepted.

Class Change Those competitors already entered may alter their entered classes up to 5 pm the day prior.

These *must be made online* to be accepted. No emails or in-person changes will be accepted. Changed entries must ride first in drawn classes. Class changes incur 25%

retained.

Scratchings You no longer wish to, or are not able to, compete in a class and are withdrawing. All

scratchings should be completed *online* by 5 pm the day prior. In late or unexpected situations, your scratching *must still be notified* to the ring steward of your class, as well

as updated online.

#### Fees and Levies

Ground Levy - \$25 per horse/pony

Medical/Admin Levy - \$25 per rider (non-refundable)

Covid Contribution - \$20 per rider (non-refundable) to help towards the additional costs of running under Covid

ESNZ Jumping Levy - \$5 per horse/pony

**Stables/Covered yards -** \$50 for the show. Only horses entered and competing will be allocated yards or stables.

Open vards - \$30 for the show.

These must be pre-booked. Preference will be given to those competing at higher levels. If yards are left dirty competitors will not have a yard allocated to them in the future and may be invoiced for costs.

**Refunds** less 25% if notified to the event secretary by 7.00 pm three days prior to the show. Refunds after that are less 50% at the committee's discretion.

**Money owed -** this show will use the ESNZ Jumping Policy on Debt Collection to follow up any unpaid accounts. This can be found on the ESNZ website.

**Prize money -** will be paid out by direct credit within 14 days after the show. *Include your bank details* with your entry.

**Cancellation -** In case of cancellation, the medical/admin fee and covid fee will be (and a small percentage of entry fees may be) retained to cover out of pocket expenses only.

#### **General Conditions**

- 1. All classes run under ESNZ rules. All Series Final classes run under ESNZ Jumping and Show Hunter Series Final conditions.
- 2. All competitors and their support persons MUST comply with all covid requirements. Those completing entries are responsible for ensuring any support persons or guests are aware of all event rules. Any failure to comply will result in your entry being cancelled without refund. This includes your return of required paperwork prior to the event commencing.
- 3. The committee reserves the right to alter the programme.
- 4. Ring 1 to be run in strict catalogue order. All rings will run to draw order, with preference given to competitors with Ring 1 commitments.
- 5. Please ensure registrations and memberships are up to date. Failure to do so may result in loss of points, placings, prize money after the show and may result in a rider being fined under ESNZ Jumping conditions.
- 6. Horses/ponies can compete under the casual levy system as per ESNZ regulations.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Committee reserves the right to evict and eliminate anyone who is acting in an unacceptable manner.
- 8. Motorbikes are not to be ridden between the hours of 8pm and 6am. Motorbike riders must wear a helmet.
- 9. Standard of dress is FORMAL. Tidy attire must be worn whilst walking courses.
- 10. **Dogs are not encouraged.** If you find it necessary to bring your dog, it **MUST be on a lead or tied up at ALL times during events**. Any wandering dogs will result in owners being asked to leave the grounds.
- 11. Photographers on the grounds are by application and/or invitation only. Any photographer outside of this may be asked to leave.
- 12. Competitors enter at their own risk and the organisers take no responsibility for any injury to horses, riders or spectators or any damage to competitors or spectators property.
- 13. Food trucks will be on site for the duration of the event.

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE to riders about MEDIA

By entering or attending this competition, you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please apply caution posting your own media that your picture shows good Covid practice and could not be taken out of context.

#### **Show Hunter conditions**

- 1. All Riders must have a current ESNZ Rider Membership to compete in ANY Show Hunter Classes
- 2. All Equines must have a Current ESNZ Equine Registration and an Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start to gain Horse of the Year Qualifying Points but can compete on a casual jumping levy WITHOUT earning points.
- 3. This is a Horse of the Year Qualifying Show for the 2022-2023 Season.
- 4. Ponies must compete in the correct category for ESNZ Hi Points classes, and must have a current height certificate to compete.
