Thank you for Installing ExhibitView 4.2
Our all Attorney requested upgrades in this release.

There are a few things to be aware of when installing ExhibitView.

- You will need to input your license key to fully activate. It's the same for all you computers. We count "activations" like Microsoft does. So, 1 key = as many activations as you purchased.
- Windows 7 "might" return an installation error if your font settings are set to 125%. Make this 96dpi default.
- You must be logged on as an administrator to install ExhibitView.
- Are the sample slides not showing? If you create a NEW slide, is it black? Your graphics driver on some computers and laptops MAY need updating. Check your system to see what your graphics card is and go to the company website and UPDATE your computer to use the latest graphics drivers. This resolves this issues 99% of the time.

- If your desktop is OLDER :-) == you may need to download a newer version of Microsoft's Directx. If you experience any problems with SlideMaker or slides being displayed, just go to <http://www.microsoft.com/downloads/details.aspx?FamilyID=2da43d38-db71-4c1b-bc6a-9b6652cd92a3&displaylang=en> and follow the update procedure. If you Slides display properly in the sample project your good to go!

SCREEN RESOLUTION & Projector Set-UP (Windows 7)

ExhibitView is designed to run on a single monitor system in the office. You may run 2 monitors in your office as well. In a courtroom or during a presentation, you must run ExhibitView on a laptop, hooked up to a projector and run the laptop in **EXTENDED DESKTOP MODE**. Do not "mirror" the screen by hitting Function key & F8. Follow these easy steps..

1. Windows 7 Users can turn on/boot the laptop, hook up the projector or TV and then press these keys together and choose "Extend" ( + P), then launch ExhibitView.

All Other OS you must....

2. Turn on laptop (do not launch ExhibitView)
3. TURN OFF ALL POWER MANAGEMENT SAVE FEATURES TO "NEVER" –see your computer's manual
4. Plug in projector (or TV) to laptop and turn ON
5. If asked you will select "extend my desktop" go to step #5
6. If not asked, Open graphics properties from your control panel (or right click on your desktop and

choose Graphics Options/Properties), Choose monitors or similar and select “extend my desktop on #2 monitor” YOU WILL ONLY SEE THIS OPTION IF YOU HAVE A PROJECTOR OR SIMILAR ATTACHED TO THE LAPTOP. Launch ExhibitView. The projector output should be black with our logo in the bottom right corner. To Test....

- a. Drag a document to the presentation screen and click the projector button or hit F12 to show your items in the presentation area. F12 ON & F12 OFF to keep the projected output clean for your audience/jurors.
7. A **safe screen resolution** when using 16:9 Widescreen TV/Monitors or a basic projector seems to be
- b. 1024x768 on BOTH the laptop and the extended monitor/projector.

ExhibitView 4.2 (New & Upgraded features) March 2012

- 1) **NEW** -Checkbox to select multiple items in a tab for “delete” or drag to a favourites folder
- 2) **NEW** -Favourites folder at top of Tabs area. Can create unlimited favourites folders for putting documents, images, a/v or web pages. Save mark-ups, tab specific now.
- 3) **New**- Double click a document, image or saved web page to “FIT WIDTH” for easier viewing and zooming (similar to Adobe Acrobat Fill left and right feature)
- 4) **New** -Implementation of Ctrl+F12 for hiding and showing of extended monitor only
- 5) **New** -Implementation of the new Transcript Viewer TranscriptViewer as a Plug in APP
 - a) Load ascii transcripts
 - b) Change text size/font, Highlight, underline
 - c) Bookmark with notes (edit notes too)
 - d) Copy and paste transcript Q&A into Slidemaker
 - e) Drag and show transcript Q&A inside of the viewer, out to projector
- 6) **NEW** Single click to display any Document, image, Saved Web Page into centre screen
- 7) **NEW** Ctrl & Spacebar = Save Extended screen as image (while in 2 screen mode only)
- 8) **NEW** F11 to expand and collapse the left library pane
- 9) **NEW** WebViewer: Save as PDF and Save a Screenshot
- 10) SAVE -AS iPad. See our user guide for more information.
- 11) Project Path is now displayed in the Project Wizard.
- 12). Projects can be deleted from Wizard list by selecting and hitting DELETE.

Upgrades

- 10) **Upgrade** -Single button “toggles” for clear and recall of screen and mark-up
- 11) **Upgrade** -Faster PDF rendering
- 12) **Upgrade** -F12 = Turn on projector in any tab (WebViewer, MSFT, SynchPro)
- 13) **Upgrade** -look ExhibitView with changed icons
- 14) **Upgrade** -MSFT import using Word 2007 / 2010 COM Engine
- 15) **Upgrade** -modifications in project open Wizard, more “recent” projects showing,
- 16) **Upgrade**-new shortcuts for certain repetitive operations
- 17) **Upgrade**-smoother pen tool appearance, freehand pen tool
- 18) **Upgrade**- Save Transcripts in project folder
