1 Kings 3:11-12; Proverbs 3:5-6

- 1. What was most meaningful, memorable, or challenging to you from the message this week?
- 2. When have you seen a smart person make a dumb decision? When have you made a decision that made you question your IQ?
- 3. Read Proverbs 3:5. Why does it make sense to trust God over your own judgment?
- 4. What are some of the reasons why we lean on our own understanding to make decisions, rather than trust God with them?
- 5. Read Proverbs 3:6. Submission precedes direction. When we submit to God, He clears the path before us. When have you submitted a decision before God? How did it turn out?
- 6. Read Proverbs 3:7. What are the dangers of pride? When have you seen pride lead to poor decisions?
- 7. What is a big decision that you are facing? How can you trust God with it?

MOVING FORWARD

Are you submitting to God in all your ways? It is easy for us to trust God with the things we can't control (our children, our eternity, the future, etc.), but often difficult for us to trust God with the areas that we feel some control over (our finances, career, health, etc.). What is an area that you are holding on to? In the coming week, how will you submit to God in this area?
