Matthew 24:1-14, 29-31; Revelation 22:1-7, 12-15, 17

- What was most memorable, challenging, or encouraging from the message this week?
- 2. If you had to guess what is going to happen to the human race, what's your prediction?
- 3. The scripture has a lot to say about how the world ends. What surprises you about what Jesus has to say about the end of the world in Matthew 24:1-14, 29-31?
- 4. Revelation 22: 1-7, 12-15, 17, 20 gives us a glimpse of the very end—the renewal of heaven and earth after the end of the world as we know it. What strikes you about the picture Jesus paints of what that time will be like?
- 5. The end of the world hinges on a choice, and Jesus invites us to choose him. Read Revelation 22 again and discuss Jesus' invitation and why anyone would want to reject it.
- 6. What, if anything, is holding you back from accepting Jesus' invitation to life and love?
