## Margin Part 1: In God We Trust

Proverbs 21:20; Matthew 6:19-21; Luke 16:11; Proverbs 3:9-10;  
Malachi 3:8-10; 2 Corinthians 2:7-8a; Acts 20:35b

1. What was most meaningful, memorable, or challenging to you from the message this week?
2. How would you define a life without financial stress? (Having millions of dollars does not equate to a lack of financial stress.)
3. Read Proverbs 21:20. Where do you fall on this continuum? What steps can you take to manage your money, rather than your money managing you?
4. Read Colossians 1:9-14, the prayer Pastor Frank prayed for all of us. How can our finances honor and please God? Do your financial habits honor and please God?
5. Pastor Frank shared how he has experienced the hand of God at work in his personal life. Where have you seen the hand of God at work in your life? In what ways or situations has He provided for you?
6. Read Matthew 6:19-21. What do the desires of your heart reveal about your treasure?
7. How trustworthy are you? (Luke 16:11)
