Revelation 21:1-8

- 4. Read through Revelation 21:1-8. What surprises you about that vision of eternity, both positively and negatively?
- 5. Not all of your decisions will last forever, but some will. Discuss which ones matter and why.
- 6. In light of what we learned this week, what decisions do you need to make or change?

MOVING FORWARD

This week, re-read the scripture above along with 1 Cor. 15:35-37, 42-44; and as you do, ask God to help you better understand the promise of resurrection and the reality that you will live forever.
