

Jump into Spring by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 8 1/4 inches

- 1 - 12.5mm Neon Coral Glazed Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0889)
- 1 - 12.5mm Bright Saffron Glazed Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0890)
- 1 - 12.5mm Bright Caribbean Glazed Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0895)
- 1 - 13mm Tiny White and Red Flowers and Dots on Brown Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0841)
- 1 - 13mm White Dots on Brown Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0826)
- 1 - 13mm Coral and Black Vertical Stripes Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0834)
- 1 - 13mm Coral Leaves and Yellow Dots on White Round Bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0853)

Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Crimping
Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Jump into Spring” bracelet:

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and the loop on the lobster claw clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 2

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 13mm white dots on brown round bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0826)
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 13mm orange and blue bullseyes and dots on brown round bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 12.5mm neon coral glazed round bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0889)
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 13mm tiny white and red flowers and dots on brown round bead by Golem Design Studio (HM0841)
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 12.5mm bright Caribbean glazed round bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 15-16mm yellow daisies and ladybugs round bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 23mm medium orange and purple flower pattern on brown lentil bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 12.5mm bright saffron glazed round bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 13mm coral leaves and yellow dots on white round bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 12.5mm old lace glazed round bead by Golem Design Studio
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead
- 1 - 13mm coral and black vertical stripes round bead
- 2 - 2x4.5mm heishi bead

Step 4

String one crimp bead and the jump ring onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire.
