

Magic Witch by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 2 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 2 - Purple Velvet Swarovski Crystal Bicone Beads - 5328 - 4mm - Purple Velvet (04BI1302)
- 16 beads - Size 11 Inside Color Lined Rainbow Sunshine Orange Delica Beads - DB1777 (11DB1777)
- 12 beads - Size 11 Opaque Black Delica Beads - DB0010 (11DB0010)
- 4 beads - Drop Japanese Seed Beads - 3.4mm - Opaque Jet (SB0588)
- 2 beads - Round Czech Glass Beads - Olivine - 8mm (GL3024)
- 2 - Bell Flower Czech Glass Beads - Jet - 8mm (GL8813)
- 2 - Lily Czech Glass Beads - Jet - 12mm (GL8698)
- 4 - Base Metal Head Pins - Silver - 21 gauge - 2 inch (BM2675)
- 2 - Base Metal Eye Pins - Silver - 21 gauge - 2 inch (BM2639)
- 1 pair - Base Metal French Ear Wire with 1.5mm Ball End - Silver - 11mm (BM3092)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters



Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

Simple Loop
Attaching an Ear Wire

Instructions to complete “Magic Witch” earrings:

Step 1

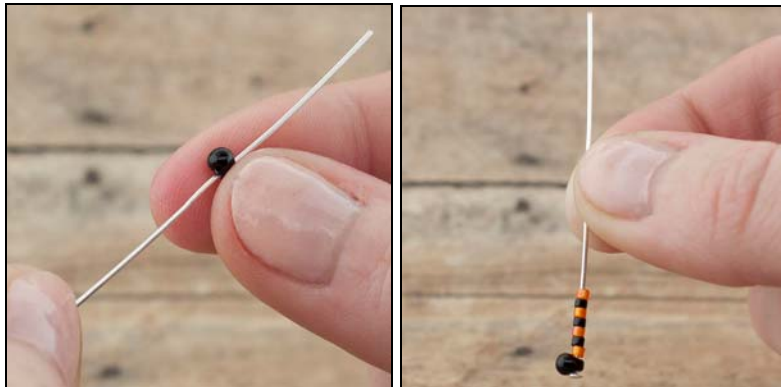
Place these beads in the following sequence onto one head pin, making one unit:

1 – 3.4mm opaque black drop seed bead

*1 – size 11 inside color lined rainbow sunshine orange Delica bead

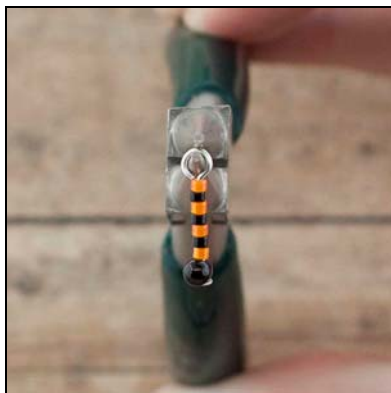
1 – size 11 opaque black Delica bead

Repeat from * twice, adding one size 11 orange Delica bead after the last repeat.



Step 2

Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin.



Step 3

Attach the loop just made to the loop on one eye pin.



Step 4

Repeat Steps 1 – 3 once, attaching the unit to the same eye pin.



Step 5

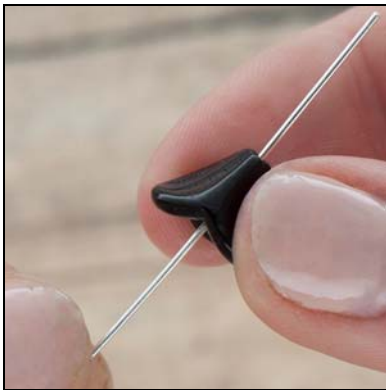
Place these beads in the following sequence onto the eye pin from the previous steps:

1 – 12mm jet lily glass bead (cupped end over the top of the witch's "legs," concealing the loops)

1 – 8mm olivine glass bead

1 – 8mm jet bell flower bead (cupped end toward the previous bead)

1 – 4mm Purple Velvet bicone bead



Step 6

Turn a simple loop at the open end of the eye pin.



Step 7

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the loop made in Step 6. Close the loop.

**Step 8**

Repeat Steps 1 – 7 for the second earring.
