- 144 4mm Amethyst Round Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL1168)
- 9 inches Base Metal 8.8mm Flat Oval Link Cable Chain Gunmetal (CN3215)
- 1 12x7mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3149)

# Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Crimping

# Instructions to complete "Knot Me" necklace:

# Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut seven 26-inch lengths of beading wire.

#### Step 2

Holding all seven lengths of beading wire together, place one crimp bead and one end link of the 9-inch length of chain onto the wires. Pass the beading wires back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead with Mighty Crimping Pliers (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

# Step 3

String 90 6mm Burgundy crystal pearls onto one strand of beading wire. Place a Bead Stopper onto the end of the wire.

# Step 4

Repeat Step 3 with the remaining strands of beading wire, stringing one type of bead onto each strand.

#### Step 5

Remove all Bead Stoppers. Holding all seven lengths of beading wire together, place one crimp bead and the split ring onto the wires. Pass the beading wires back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire.

#### Step 6

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and use the jump ring to attach the loop on the lobster claw to the unattached end chain link. Close the jump ring.

#### Step 7

Use all seven beaded strands to tie an overhand knot at the center of the necklace.
