Approximate finished length: 2.25 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 2 - 12mm Crystal Antique Pink Swarovski Crystal Rivoli Stone - 1122 (SC8359)
- 2 - 18mm Crystal Antique Pink Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone - 4320 (SC7295)
- 2 - Pewter Plain Round Rivoli Link by TierraCast - Antique Brass - 22mm (AP6082)
- 2 - Antique Brass Plated Pewter Plain Pear Bezel Drop by TierraCast - For 18mm Pear Stone (AP6253)
- 1 - Niobium French Ear Wire with Loop by TierraCast - Antique Brass - 12mm (AP6149)
- 2 - 5.5mm Antique Brass Plated Brass 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring by TierraCast (AP6106)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Chain Nose Pliers
E6000 Adhesive 0.18 Oz. Tube (TL2921)
Toothpick

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component
Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Attaching an Ear Wire

Instructions to complete “Vintage” earrings:

Step 1

Apply a drop of E6000 adhesive to the center of one 22mm glue-in setting (see Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component Technique).

Step 2

Place one crystal rivoli stone onto the adhesive, and press firmly. Allow to dry.

Step 3

Apply a drop of E6000 adhesive to the center of one 18x13mm glue-in setting.

Step 4

Place one crystal pear fancy stone onto the adhesive, and press firmly. Allow to dry.

Step 5

Use chain nose pliers to open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique).

Step 6

Attach the top loop of the 18x13 glue-in setting to the bottom loop of the 22mm glue-in setting. Close the jump ring.

Step 7

Open the loop of one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique). Attach the loop to the top loop of the 23mm glue-in setting. Close the loop.

Step 8

Repeat steps 1-7 for the second earring.
